**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
BHAKTILAND, INC.**

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following restatement of its articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I

Name

The Name of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III

Purposes

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are exclusively cultural and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, and shall be as follows:

One: To create, promote, facilitate, develop, and support a variety of artistic endeavors identified with the bhakti-yoga path.

Two: To educate the general public about the art and culture of the bhakti-yoga path.

Three: With a view toward achieving the aforementioned purposes, to produce, publish and distribute books, periodicals, musical recordings, dramatic presentations, and visual art.

Four: To receive, administer and distribute funds, and to do all other things necessary and proper in furtherance of the above-stated purposes.

ARTICLE IX

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Limitation of Corporate Powers

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, unless limited as follows:

(a) This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for cultural and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(b) The corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(c) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE X Distribution of Assets Upon Dissolution

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to cultural and educational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of the organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to or for the Corporation and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for cultural and educational purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

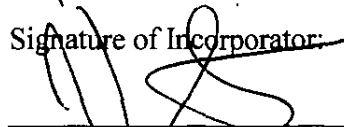

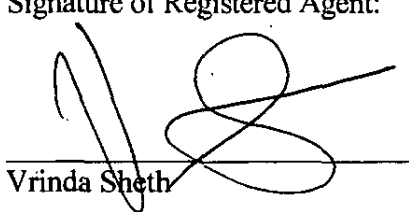
