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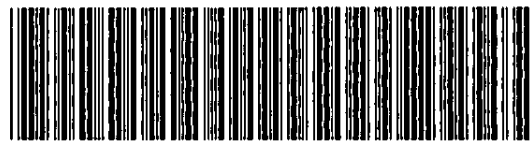

**Articles of Incorporation**

**(A Corporation Not For Profit)**

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of #teachHope, Inc. under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act (Chapter 617, F.S.) adopts the following articles of incorporation:

**Article I - Name**

The name of the corporation shall be #teachHope, Inc. (hereafter, the "Corporation").

**Article II - Principal Office/Mailing Address**

The principal office and mailing address of the corporation is 240 NW 121 Court, Miami, FL 33182.

**Article III - Duration**

The duration of the corporation is perpetual, unless sooner dissolved by the officers or shareholders as provided for by the laws of Florida.

**Article IV - Purpose**

The mission of #teachHope, Inc. is to encourage kids to help and care for the less fortunate in their community. The project is simple – show kids examples of kindness then teach them how they can do the same.

#teachHope, Inc. believes that the best way to instill in children the motivation to help others by encouraging them and providing useful avenues that allow them to make a difference. Parents, friends, and teachers simply need to help them tap into their desire to help.

The Corporation is organized and shall operate exclusively for cultural, charitable and educational purposes of conducting or supporting activities for the benefit of or to carry out the purposes of #teachHope, Inc. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The Corporation may engage in only such activities permitted under the laws of the State of Florida and the United States of America as shall constitute activities in furtherance of such exempt purposes.

No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on the propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

#### **Article V - Dedication and Distribution of Assets**

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof.

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation or the winding up of its affairs, the assets of the Corporation shall be distributed exclusively to charitable organizations which would then qualify under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

#### **Article VI - Incorporator and Address**

The Incorporator is Jocelyn Morffi and the office of the initial registered agent is located at 240 NW 121 Court Miami, FL 33182.

#### **Article VII - Initial Directors**

The power of this Corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a Board of Directors. The number of Directors may be increased or decreased from time to time as authorized by a majority vote of the members, but shall never be less than three (3) persons. Directors shall be elected to hold office in accordance with the methods prescribed in the Bylaws of the Corporation. #### **Article VIII - Bylaws**

The Board of Directors of the Corporation may provide such Bylaws for the conduct of the business of the Corporation and the carrying out of its purposes as such Directors may deem necessary from time to time. Upon notice properly given, the Bylaws may be amended, altered or restricted by majority vote of the Directors present at any regular or special meeting called for that purpose, subject to any limitations set forth in the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act.

#### **Article IX - Amendments to Articles of Incorporation**

An amendment to these Articles of incorporation may be proposed by any Director of the Corporation, but such amendment may be adopted only after receiving an affirmative vote of the majority of the Directors.

Article X - Initial Registered Agent and Street Address


The initial registered agent of the Corporation is Jocelyn Morffi, and the office of the initial registered agent is 240 NW 121 Court, Miami, FL 33182.

I hereby am familiar with and accept the duties and responsibilities as Registered Agent.

Article XI - Indemnification

Every person who now is or hereafter shall be a Director or Officer of the Corporation shall be indemnified to the fullest extent permitted by law by the Corporation against all costs and expenses (including counsel fees) hereafter reasonably imposed upon him or her in conjunction with, or resulting from, any action, suit or proceedings of whatever nature, to which (s)he is or shall be made a party by reason of his or her having been a Director or Officer of the Corporation (whether or not (s)he is a Director or Officer of the Corporation at the time (s)he is made a party to such action, suit or proceeding, or at the time such cost or expense is incurred by or imposed upon him or her). The right of indemnification herein provided shall not be exclusive of other rights to which any such person may now or hereafter be entitled as a matter of law.

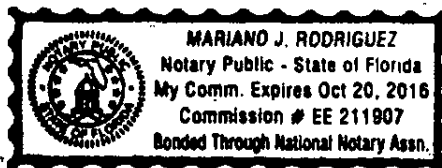
