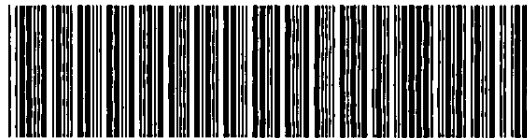

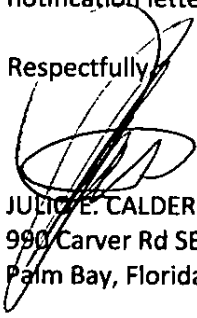

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S.; (Not for Profit)

## ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this non-profit corporation shall be:

## ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office will be located in the city of Orlando, Orange County, in the central Region of the State of Florida. The mailing address shall be: "Florida Chapter; Poly-Inter Alumni Association; c/o IAU Cybernetic Center; 13574 Village Park Drive; Orlando, FL 32837."

## ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

## ARTICLE X: ORGANIZATION

3. The separation of a member will be based on his/her voluntary resignation, death or by action of the Board of Directors, pursuant to approved procedures outlined in the chapter's Constitution and By-Laws, as approved by the general assembly.

**ARTICLE XII: FUNDS**

The source of all funds will be in accordance with the chapter's constitution, to wit: Dues paid by members and friends; income from periodic approved activities as permitted by law; voluntary donations from members and friends; and from others lawful sources approved by the assembly. All collected funds will be used for the payment of liabilities, debts and other obligations incurred in the fulfillment of the goals and objectives of the chapter. Proper accounting records are to be maintained.

**ARTICLE XIII: AMMENDMENTS**

The chapter's constitution and by-laws can be amended by the affirmative vote of at least two-third of the members present in a duly convened general assembly.

**ARTICLE XIV: ACCOUNTING**

The fiscal year of this organization will be 1 July to 30 June of every calendar year.

**ARTICLE XV: TERM**

This corporation shall exist until duly dissolved by the process of law. Should the corporation ceases to exist as a legal entity and it is terminated, title to all property shall automatically become vested as follow: Upon the dissolution, the assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purpose within the meaning of Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future Federal Code. Or shall be distributed to the Federal State or local government for public purpose. Any such assets, not so disposed, shall be disposed of by a court of common pleas of the county in which the principal office is located,.

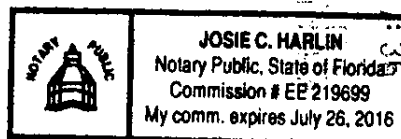
