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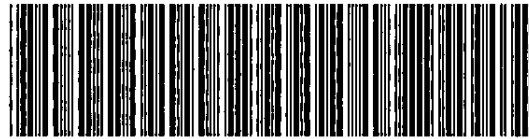

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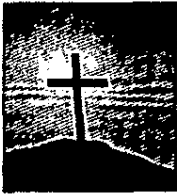

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Article I – Corporation Name:

The name of the Corporation shall be CENTRO DE VIDA INTEGRAL, INC.

Article II – Principal Address:

Article III – Purpose for Organizing:

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

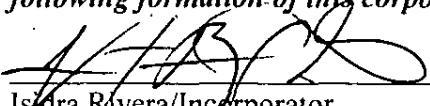
