ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be THE SCHICK FOUNDATION.

The places where the principal offices of this corporation shall be located will be 228 B. E. 2nd Avenue, Hiami, Florida, and in care of Mrs. Kenneth C. Sifford, Wilton, Connecticut, and each other or substitute locations, within or without the State of Plorida, as the Seard of Directors of the corporation may from time to time designate and establish.

ARTICLS II.

The general nature of the objects and purposes of the corporation shall(he as follows:

- 1. This corporation shall engage only in such activities as are permitted to corporations whose income is exempt from taxaction under Section 101 of the Internal Revenue Gode of the United States from time to time existing, and similar or substitute sections of said Gode.
