ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC. A FLORIDA NOT -FOR- PROFIT CORPORATION. English translation: VOICE OF LIFE INTERNATIONAL MINISTRY, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to the Florida Nos for Profit

Corporation Act, In compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of

Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

<u>Name</u>

The name of the corporation shall be: MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC. English translation: Voice of Life International Ministry, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Location of Principal Office

Its initial office shall be at 29 Old Kings Road North, Suite 8-B, Palm Coast, FL., 32137

With mailing address of P.O. Box 350623, Palm Coast, FL 32135-0623

ARTICLE III

Purpose

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes. To establish and oversee places of worship, conduct the work of evangelism worldwide, create departments necessary to support ministry and missionary activities, ordain, license, commission and oversee ministers of the Gospel. To engage in activities which are necessary, suitable or convenient for the accomplishment of that purpose or which are incidental thereto or

connected therewith which are consistent with section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV

Specific purposes

The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is to establish and oversee places of worship for the preaching of The Gospel of Jesus Christ and foster the growth of the Kingdom of God in all places. To regularly assemble the members of the church to worship God and to cooperate in the assembling of the whole body of Christ and to observe the teachings and ordinances of the Bible. To bring individuals and families of believers and potential believers in the Lord Jesus Christ together in fellowship, both in the church and in homes through cell groups. To teach and preach the Gospel through speaking engagements at different venues and through radio, television, internet, social media and all means available and necessary, and in any language necessary. To produce and distribute, literature, to conduct public evangelistic activities, to offer bible based classes, to provide spiritual counseling and to also engage in activities which are necessary, suitable or convenient for the accomplishment of those purposes. To offer mentoring, discipleship, and other practical support: to create departments necessary to support all these activities and to engage in activities which are necessary, suitable or convenient for the accomplishment of that purpose. To establish and maintain institutions that will create Christian training schools including all levels of education, such as preschools, elementary schools, high schools, colleges, bible training schools and universities or any other schools which may be deemed necessary for the teaching and spreading of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. To receive, manage, and distribute gifts, bequests, and other funds for the benefit of the

ministries of MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC.; to own and maintain suitable buildings and facilities necessary for their acquisition, upkeep, maintenance and sale.

To act as the central organization (church) that oversees other tax-exempt organizations who will act as subordinate churches and ministries. To establish and maintain charitable institutions; such as homes for children, pregnancy care centers, aged ministers, missionaries, short term housing for the destitute or the elders or any other institutions which may be deemed necessary. To serve the community through life enhancing programs and character development experiences: to offer mentoring, tutoring, life skill management classes, guidance counseling, food and clothing programs, and operations of day and summer camps. To create departments necessary to support all these activities and to also engage in activities which are necessary, suitable or convenient for the accomplishment of such purpose. To establish and maintain any future places, departments or activities not aforementioned to support all said purposes for the cause of The Gospel, in accordance with the Constitution and Bylaws of MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC. To provide spiritual support and covering for other new or existing churches and ministries, according to the provisions stated in the Constitutions and Bylaws of MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC. To conduct the work of evangelism, create departments necessary to support missionary activities. To carry on the organization of churches and to foster their development, according to the tenets of MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC. To ordain, license, commission and oversee ministers of the Gospel whom shall establish other domestic and foreign places of worship and whom shall be independent churches and or ministries in good standing with MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC., and will conduct the affairs of the congregations according to the rules and regulations of MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC. specifically by the, Policies and Procedures, Constitution and Bylaws of MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC.; and whom will promote the cause of The Gospel in accordance with the teachings, tenets, and customs of MINISTERIO

INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC.; and whom will operate under their own constitution and bylaws in accordance with the constitution and bylaws of MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC., which shall never contradict nor violate the framework of the constitution and bylaws of MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC. and whom will engage in activities which are necessary, suitable or convenient for the accomplishment of the purpose of MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC.; and whom also would receive, manage, and distribute gifts, bequests, and other funds for the benefit of the ministries of MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC. and who will also own and maintain suitable buildings and facilities necessary for their acquisition, upkeep, maintenance and sale, all in accordance with the Constitution and Bylaws of MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC.

ARTICLE V

Term

The corporation shall exist perpetually until dissolved by due process of law.

ARTICLE VI

Directors and Trustees

ARTICLE VII

Management of Corporate Affairs

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors: the Board shall have three (3) Board Members initially, herein referred to from time to time as: Board Directors or Board Members or Officers or Trustees. The number of Directors of the corporation may be increased or diminished from time to time by the Bylaws but shall never be less than three (3). The method of selection of directors, as well as the powers, control and affairs of the Board of Directors shall be stated in the Bylaws of this corporation.

Membership: This Corporation church shall have members. The eligibility, rights, and obligations of the members will be determined by the organization's Bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII

Corporate Powers

The corporation shall have all of the powers conferred by the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, which are necessary, incidental, or convenient to the purposes of the corporation as herein stated.

<u>ARTICLE IX</u>

Activities not permitted

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation will not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law or (b) a corporation, contributions of which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or any other corresponding provision of any or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purpose of this corporation."

ARTICLE X

<u>Dedication and Distribution of Assets</u>

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose clause set forth in Article III and IV hereof.

ARTICLE XI

Bylaws

The Board of Directors of the corporation shall conduct business under the Bylaws of the corporation in order to carry out its purposes as such Directors may deem necessary from time to time. Upon notice properly given, the Bylaws may be amended, altered or rescinded by the Directors present at any regular or special meeting called for that purpose, subject to any limitations set forth in the Florida Not for Profit Corporation act concerning corporate action that must be authorized or approved by officers of the corporation, <u>provided</u> that the proposed amendment does not conflict with these Articles of Incorporation and is in accord with the Bylaws and Constitution of MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL VOZ DE VIDA, INC.

ARTICLE XII

Dissolution

In the event of dissolution of the corporation, no part of the corporation's earnings or assets shall inure to the benefit of any of its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons; all assets remaining after the payment of debts and liabilities and/or the residual assets of the corporation shall be distributed to one or more organizations as per this corporation's distribution plan contain in its Policies and Procedures, such organizations themselves shall be exempt as organizations described in sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding sections of any prior or future law, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization(s), as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
