## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

#### SPRINGWATER CHURCH OF BRANDON, INC.

WHEREAS, Springwater Church of Brandon, Inc. is a church and a unit of the Presbytery of Tampa Bay, (hereinafter referred to as "the Presbytery"), and a unit of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.); and

WHEREAS, Springwater Church of Brandon, Inc., the Presbytery, the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), and any civil agencies related to them are exempt organizations under §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code; and

WHEREAS, the Form of Government of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) provides for the incorporation of a church to receive, hold; encumber, manage and transfer property and to facilitate the management of its civil affairs in such a manner as may be directed by its session from time to time and according to the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.); and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to create a Florida not-for-profit corporation for Springwater Church of Brandon, Inc. to comply with the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, I, the undersigned, as the subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, do hereby form a not-for-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

#### ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation is **Springwater Church of Brandon**, **Inc.** (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation").

### ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

106 Wense Avenue, Seffner FL 33584

### ARTICLE III TYPE

The Corporation is a nonprofit religious corporation.

The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

### ARTICLE IV PURPOSES

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are more fully set forth in the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), including:

The Great Ends of the church (Book of Order F-1.0304):

- the proclamation of the gospel for the salvation of humankind;
- the shelter, nurture, and spiritual fellowship of the children of God;
- the maintenance of divine worship;
- the preservation of the truth;
- the promotion of social righteousness; and
- the exhibition of the kingdom of heaven to the world.

In furtherance of the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and the purposes stated above, the Corporation shall exercise powers as set out herein.

#### ARTICLE V

#### SUPPORT AND CONFORM TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (U.S.A.)

The Corporation shall support, at all times and in all respects, the *Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)*. The Corporation and all of its property, both real and personal, shall be subject to the *Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)*, as it is now or shall be, from time to time, amended, established, made, and declared by the authority of the the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). The business of the Corporation shall be conducted in conformity with the *Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)*, as it is now or shall be, from time to time, amended, established, made, and declared by the authority of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.).

#### ARTICLE VI

#### ALL PROPERTY HELD IN TRUST FOR THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (Ú.S.A.)

All property, both real or personal, held by or for the particular church, whether title is lodged in the Corporation, the board of trustees or a trustee, or an unincorporated association, and whether the property is used in programs of the particular church or retained for the production of income, is held in trust nevertheless for the use and benefit of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). (Book of Order G-4.0203).

### ARTICLE VII POWERS AND DUTIES

The Corporation shall have the powers and duties granted by the *Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)*. (Book of Order G-4.0203):

To receive, hold, encumber, manage, and transfer property, real or personal, for the congregation provided that in buying, selling, and mortgaging real property, the trustees shall act only after the approval of the congregation, granted in a duly constituted meeting and subject to the congregation obtaining written permission of the Presbytery transmitted through the session of the congregation;

To accept and execute deeds of title to such property;

To hold and defend title to such property;

To manage any permanent special funds for the furtherance of the purposes of the congregation.

All of the above are subject to Book of Order G-4.0101 and Book of Order G-4.0206(a).

In addition, to the extent not included in the above and not inconsistent with the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), the Corporation shall have all of the general powers of a nonprofit religious corporation organized pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

The powers and duties of the trustees shall not infringe upon the powers and duties of the session and the board of deacons of the congregation and such powers and duties shall be exercised in conformity with the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) (Book of Corder G-4.0101, G-3.0201). In addition, the Corporation shall not engage in ultra vires acts.

### ARTICLE VIII MEMBERS

Only members on the active role of the Springwater Church of Brandon shall be members of the Corporation and eligible for election as Trustees. (Book of Order G-4.0102).

### ARTICLE IX TRUSTEES

The management and disposition of the affairs and property of the Corporation shall be vested in Trustees, who shall be selected from time to time in such manner, with such terms, in such number and at such times as the Bylaws of this Corporation may provide. The number of such Trustees may be increased or decreased at any time by the Bylaws, but the number of Trustees shall never be less than three (3). All the business of the Corporation shall be conducted by the Trustees under and subject to the direction of the laws of the State of Florida and of the United States of America.

### ARTICLE X OFFICERS

The Bylaws identify and provide for the method of election or appointment of the officers of the Corporation.

#### ARTICLE XI BYLAWS

The Bylaws of the Corporation shall be in conformity with the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), as it is now or shall be, from time to time, amended, established, made, and declared by the authority of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). The Bylaws will be adopted by the members of the Corporation and may be amended or repealed by the members of the Corporation but must at all times and in all respects remain in conformity with the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.).

### ARTICLE XII INITIAL BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The number of trustees constituting the initial Board of Trustees shall be five and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial Trustees and until their successors are elected and installed are:

### ARTICLE XV AMENDMENTS

The articles of incorporation of the Corporation may be amended or added to for new articles of incorporation may be adopted, by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the Corporation; provided that the articles of incorporation must at all times and in all respects remain in conformity with the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). (Book of Order G-4.0204, G-4.0205, G-3.0301)

#### ARTICLE XVI

#### RESTRICTIONS ON CORPORATIONS EXEMPT FROM FEDERAL TAXATION

No part of the assets of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes of the Corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal

Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

### ARTICLE XVII DISSOLUTION

If the congregation is formally dissolved by the Presbytery of which it is a member, or has become extinct by reason of the dispersal of its members, the abandonment of its work, or any other cause, all such property, both real and personal, present and future, as the Corporation may have shall be vested in and be the property of the Presbytery of Tampa Bay of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), pursuant to the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), said Presbytery being an organization qualified under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States. In the alternative, said property of the Corporation shall be held, used and applied for such uses, purposes and trust as the Presbytery may direct, limit and appoint, or such property may be sold or disposed of as the Presbytery may direct in conformity with the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). (Book of Order G-4.0204, G-4.0205, G-3.0301).
