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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

EAST SHENANDOAH CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC.

We, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a not-for-profit corporation in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, acknowledge and file these Articles of Incorporation in the Office of the Secretary of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I-NAME

The name of this corporation shall be East Shenendoah Condominium Association, Inc. For convenience, the corporation shall berein be referred to as the "Association".

ARTICLE III-PURPOSE AND POWERS

The Association shall have the following powers:

- A. To manage, operate and administer East Shenandeah Condominium Association, Inc., a condominium (referred to herein as the "Condominium"), and to undertake the performance of, and to carry out the acts and duties incident to the administration of the Condominium in accordance with the terms, provisions, conditions and authorizations contained in these Articles, the Association's By-laws and the Declaration of Condominium recorded among the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida.
- B. To horrow money and issue evidences of indebtedness in furthersnes of any or all of the objects of its business; to secure the same by mortgage, deed of trust, pledge or other lien.
- C. To carry out the duties and obligations and receive the benefits given the Association by the Declaration of Condominium.
- D. To establish By-Laws and Rules and Regulations for the operation of the Association and to provide for the formal administration of the Association, to enforce the Condominium Act as of the State of Florida, the Declaration of Condominium, the by-Laws and the Rules and Regulations of the Association.
 - E. To contract for the management of the Condominium,
- F. To acquire, own, operate, mortgage, lease, sell and trade property, whether real or personal, as may be necessary or convenient in the administration of the Condominium.
- G. The Association shall have all the common law and acatucory powers and duties set forth in Chapter 718, Florida Statutes, as amended (one "Condominium Act") and the Declaration of Condominium for the Condominium and all other powers and duties reasonably necessary to operate the Condominium pursuant to its Declaration of Condominium, as same may be amended from time to time.

ARTICLE III-MEMBERS

- A. Each unit owner in the Condominium and the Subscriber to these Articles shall automatically be members of the Association. Membership of the Subscriber shall terminate upon the entire Board of Directors of the Association peing selected by unit owners other than the Developer.
- B. Membership, as to all members other than the Subscriber, shall commence up the acquisition of record title to a unit we evidenced by the recording of a deed of conveyance amongst the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida or, as provided in the Declaration of Condominium, upon transfer of title upon the death of a member and membership shall terminate upon the divestment of title co-said unit.
- C. On all matters at to which the membership shall be entitled to vote, there shall be only one vote for each Unit, as said term is defined in the Declaration of Condominium, which vote shall be exercised in the manner provided by the Declaration of Condominium and the By-Levs.
- O. The share of a member in the funds and essets of the Association cannot be assigned, hypothecated or transferred in any manner except as an appurtenance to his/her unit.

ARTICLE IV-BEISTENCE

The Association shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VIII-BY-LAWS

The By-Laws of the Association shall be proposed and adopted by the initial Board of Directors. The By-Laws may be amended in accordance with the provisions thereof, except that no portion ob the By-Laws may be altered, omended, or reacinged in such a manner as would prejudice the rights of the Developer of the Condominium or mortgages holding mortgages encumbering units in the Condominium, without their prior written consent.

ARTICLE IX-AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES

Amendments to these Articles shall be proposed and adopted in the following danner:

- A. Notice of the subject matter of any proposed amendment shall be included in the notice of the meeting at which the proposed amendment is to be considered.
- B. A resolution for the adoption of a proposed amendment may be proposed either by the Board of Birectors, acting upon the vote a majority of the Board of Directors, or by the members of the Association having a majority of the votes in the Association. In order for any amendment or amendments to be effective, same must be approved by an affirmative vote of 66-2/3% of the entire Board of Directors and by an affirmative vote of members having no less that 75% of the total votes in the Association.
- C. No amendment shall make any changes in the qualifications for membership nor in the voting rights of members of the Association, without approval in writing by all members and joinder of all record owners of wortgages encumbering condominium units. No amendment shall be made that is in conflict with the Condominium Act or the Declaration of Condominium.
- D. A copy of each emendment adopted shall be filed within ten (10) days of adoption with the Secretary of State, pursuant to the provisions of applicable Plorida Statutes.

ARTICLE X-INDEMNIFICATION

Every Director and every Officer of the Ausociation shall be indomnified by the Association and by each member of the Association against all expenses and liabilities, including counsel fees reasonably incurred by or imposed upon the Director(s) or Officer(s) in connections with any proceeding or any Settlemont thereof to which the Director(s) or Officer(s) may be a party, or in which the Director(s) or Officer(s) may be some involved by reason of the Director(s) or Officer(s) being or having been a Director(s) or Officer(s) of the Association.

whether or not a Director(s) or Officer(s) at the time of such expenses are incurred, except in such cases wherein the Director(s) or Officer(s) is adjugged guilty of willful miscenduct in the performance of such Director's or Officer(s) duty: provided that in the event of a settlement, the indemnification set forth herein shall apply only when the Board of Directors, exclusive of any Director(s) eacking indemnification, approves such settlement and reimbursement as being for the best interest of the Association. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all of the rights to which such Director(s) or Officer(s) may be entitled.
