

NONPROFIT CORPORATION ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

For the purpose of forming a Florida not-for-profit corporation pursuant to §617 of the laws of Florida, the undersigned hereby submits these Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1

Name

The name of the corporation is SARTQ, Inc.

ARTICLE 2

Existence

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE 3

Effective Date

The effective date of incorporation shall be upon filing by the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE 4

Members

The corporation will have nonvoting members.

ARTICLE 5

Type of non-profit corporation

The corporation is not for profit and will be organized as a public charity under IRC 501(c)(3).

ARTICLE 6

ARTICLE 9

Directors are elected or appointed as provided for in the corporation's bylaws.

ARTICLE 10
Indemnification

The corporation does indemnify any directors, officers, employees, incorporators, and members of the corporation from any liability regarding the corporation and the affairs of the corporation, unless the person fraudulently and intentionally violated the law and/or maliciously conducted acts to damage and/or defraud the corporation, or as otherwise provided under applicable statute.

ARTICLE 11
Purpose

The purpose of the corporation is exclusively for community outreach ,charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the internal revenue code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code and herein stated as follows:

The corporation engages the community through unique artistic experiences, and strives to support the local creative community, produce temporary roaming exhibitions, create educational opportunities in the community, and expose the public to how artists function in society.

ARTICLE 12

Prohibited Activities

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 11.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE 13

Distributions Upon Dissolution


Upon the dissolution of the corporation, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the legal liabilities of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
