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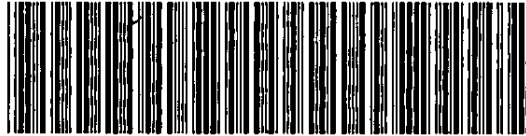

### **Article VIII. Amendment**

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended, subject to any requirements of law, by an affirmative vote of three-quarters (3/4) of all the members of the Board of Directors at any properly called meeting of the Board of Directors, provided that the notice of such meeting shall contain a copy of the proposed amendment or amendments, and provided that the amendment or amendments adopted shall not vary in intent from the proposed amendment or amendments.

## **FHEE WICL, Inc. Purpose Statement**

**PURPOSE:** FaithHealthEdEcon (FHEE) Wellness Initiative Calhoun Liberty (WICL) is a non-profit Community Outreach and Preventative Medicine program founded by Virginia Baker, PhD, in response to the personal witness of a lack of patient education and care in Calhoun and Liberty Counties; areas of critical medical need as designated by the Department of Health. The organization began as a non-profit extension of the Panhandle Pioneer Settlement, and is in the process of seeking non-profit independent status in 2014. The specific purpose of FHEE WICL is to **unite community resources, and empower them to deliver expertise through a network of collaboration through education in two areas:**

### **1.) PREVENTATIVE MEDICINE:**

- FaithHealthEdEcon Wellness Initiative has just sponsored a **Community Preventative Medicine and Outreach Program** -- in collaboration with physicians from World Health Mission (August 24– 30, 2014)-- to address the DOH Calhoun and Liberty County community status of ***Areas of Critical Medical Need; Diabetes, Hypertension, Obesity***. The educational outreach was based on collaboration (DOH, UF/IFAS, Florida Baptist Association, PANCARE of Florida).
- The **long-term, self-help based program for prevention of chronic disease in diabetes, hypertension and obesity** documents outcome changes (monitored by the enrolled participants, themselves, HIPAA guidelines) at the **Calhoun County Public Library Systems (six branches) on Saturday mornings from 10:00 to 12:00 cst.**
- Those combating diabetes, hypertension or obesity may join the educational FHEE WICL Preventative Medicine & Community Outreach Program on the first Saturday of the month (10:00 – 12:00) at the Calhoun County Public Library Six Branch. All people are welcome to join the self-help preventative medicine educational program.

### **2.) COMMUNITY OUTREACH:**

- FHEE WICL has **sponsored students in the UF/IFAS Master Gardening (MG) Certification Course to provide the community with a sustainable alternative to processed food, and an alternative to the *Back Pack Program* (that provides food to underprivileged).**
- FHEE WICL assists in the support of graduates of the MG program through the development of **local community gardens (raised-beds or in ground --as resources permit), designed to provide non-genetically modified foods to families, church communities, and local groups.**
- In the future, FHEE WICL will **collaborate and educate for sustainable economic development;** eg, referral for development of bed and breakfasts with local proprietorship, non-genetically modified food for local and area-wide distribution, encourage eco/event-tourism through the Chamber of Commerce and River Way

South, incorporating environmentally defined restraints.

**Immediate and Long-term GOALS:** 2014 Calhoun County Public Library System (CCPL), six branches:

1. Preventative Medicine and Community Outreach:
  - a. Intervention through self-help education:
    - Diabetes (glucometer), hypertension (blood pressure cuff), obesity (scale, determine BMI). (Immediate Goal Accomplished; in expansion phase)
  - b. Self-help strategy based on intervention and prevention:
    - i. FHEE WICL Health Kits at Six Branches of Calhoun County Public Library. (Immediate Goal Accomplished; in expansion phase)
    - ii. Patrons of library sign waiver and educated/taught to use kits. (Immediate Goal Accomplished; in expansion phase)
    - iii. Patrons of library/FHEE WICL voluntary participants allowed access to kits and other educational series/ opportunities for self-help. (Immediate Goal Accomplished; in expansion phase)
    - iv. All individuals educated to access health care options available in a rural setting, regardless of insurance.
  - b. Decrease in unnecessary use of Hospital Ambulance through community preventative medicine/educational intervention in diabetes, hypertension and obesity chronic morbidity; Increase in establishment of physician-patient relationship in the population without; Increase in effectiveness of Emergency Department as emergent facility and decrease in the overall cost of medicine/burden of unpaid bills through preventative medicine and patient education. (Long-term Goal)
2. COMMUNITY GARDENS:
  - a. Master Gardener Certification (through UF/IFAS) and
  - b. Participation in building Community Gardens (raised bed if needed) at six CCPL Branches.
  - c. Provision of food, based on self-help program.
3. LONG TERM: Integrate Referral Program for Economic Development

B. GOALS: 2015 Extension of FHEE WICL Model into Liberty County.

C. GOALS: 2016 Extension of FHEE WICL Model into other Counties in areas of critical need.

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
