ARTICLE III

The purpose of which this corporation is formed are exclusively charitable, educational, social, religious, and economic and will consist of the following:

A. The specific and primary purposes are:

- (1) To raise the economic, educational, and social levels of the residents of Putnam County, including members of the moderate, low and very low income community, who are substantially unemployed, underemployed, or whose income is below federal poverty guidelines. Also to foster and promote community wide interest and concern for the problems of said residents to the end that (a) educational and economic opportunities may be expanded; (b) sickness, poverty, crime, and environmental degradation may be lessoned; and (c) racial tension, prejudice, and discrimination may be eliminated; and (d) need for establishing and fostering additional availability of affordable housing.
- groups to own, manage, and operate business enterprises in economically depressed areas; to assist said residents and groups in developing entrepreneurial and management skills necessary for the successful operation of business enterprises; and to assist said residents and groups in obtaining financial support from other sources.
- (3) To expand opportunities available to said residents and groups to obtain adequate low-cost housing accomation by constructing, rehabilitating, and providing decent safe and sanitary housing for persons and families of low-income who otherwise would not be able to find or afford a suitable place to live. It is this purpose of the corporation thereby

to relieve the poor, distressed, underpriviledged and indigent by enabling them to secure the basic human needs of decent shelter and to thus lessen the burdens of government and promote the social welfare of said residents.

- (4) To aid, support and assist by gifts, contributions, or otherwise to assist other corporations and foundations organized for charitable, educational or scientific purposes. No part of the net earnings of which endures to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual, and no substantial part of the activities of which is for carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.
- (5) To do any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful wor desirable for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering or attaining of the foregoing purposes, either directly or indirectly, and either alone or in conjunction with others, whether such others b persons or organizations of any kiind or nature, including corporations, firms associations, trusts, institutions, foundations, or governmental bureaus or agencies.
 - B. In furtherance, but not in limitation, of the foregoing charitable, educational and scientific purposes, the Corporation shall have the following powers:
 - (1) To solicit, collect and receive money and other assets, and to administer funds and contributions received by grant, gifts, deed, bequest or devise, and otherwise to acquire money, securtities, property, rights and services of every kind and description, and to hold, invest, expend, contribute, use, sell, or otherwise dispose of any money, securities, property, rights, or services so acquired for the purpose above mentioned. In addition, to hold social and civic entertainment for the community.
 - (2) To borrow money, and to make, accept, endorse, execute and issue bonds, debentukres, promissory notes, and other corporated

obligations for monies borrowed, or in payment for property acquired or for any of the purposes of the Corporation, and to secure payment of any such obligation by mortgage, pledge, deed indenture agreement or other instrument of trust or by lien.

- (3) To invest and reinvestits funds in such mortgages, bonds, notes shares of common stock and any other securities of any kind whatsoever, and property, real, personal or mixed, tangible or intangible, all as the Corporation's Board of Directors shall deem advisable and as may be permitted by law.
- (4) To engage in activity of operating business ventures for the purpose of providing job training, employment services, and managerial development opportunities to said residents for the chairitable purpose of furthering the economic development of the community. To have public recreation activities for the community.
- (5) To hire and fire employees and to contract for outside services at the will of the Corporation.
- (6) To engage in any and all activities which will directly or indirectly improve the welfare and economic conditions of said residents and groups.
- (7) To excercise all rights and powers confered upon corporations formed under the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of Florida, provided that the Corporation shall not engage in any activities or excercise any powers, including those specifically mentioned herein, that are not in furtherance of the specific and primarily charitable, educational and scienific purposes of the Corporation.
- (8) The operation of said Corporation shall also include the concerns of:

A. Entertainment

- B. Transportation
- C. Historical Preservation
- D. Elderly Assistance
- E. Social Services Referrals
- F. Legal Services Referrals
- G. Recreation, Nutrition, and Health
- C. All of the foregoing purposes and powers shall be excercised exclusively for charitable ande educational purposes in such manner that the Corporation shall qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501 (c)
 (3) of the Internal Revenue Code as it is currently and shall hereafter be in force and effect.
