

WHEREAS, the Eric Marder Scholarship Fund (the "Corporation") has operated since 2015 as a not-for-profit charitable organization that raised money and gave scholarships to students with financial need who were suffering from a primary immune deficiency disease for educational purposes, including attending college, trade school, or for other educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has considered options for the Corporation and determined that the Corporation should cease operations and dissolve; it is
