The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States of America, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: SUNRAYS OUTREACH MINISTRY, INC.

ARTICLE II: PLACE

The place in this state where the principal office the Corporation is to be located is:

- 7) Make contracts, incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the directors may determine, issue its notes, bonds, and other obligations by mortgage and pledge any or all of its property, franchises or income
- 8) Conducts its affairs, carry on its operations and have officers and exercise the powers granted by this Article in any state, territory, district or possession of the United States or any foreign country.
- 9) Purchase, take, receive, lease, take by gift, devise or bequest, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use or otherwise deal in and with real or personal property, or any interest therein, where so ever situate.

- 10) Acquire, enjoy, utilize, and dispose of patents, copyrights, and trademarks, and any licenses, and other rights or interests therein or there under
- 11) Sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, transfer or otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets.
- 12) Purchase, take, receive, subscribe for otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge or otherwise dispose of and otherwise use and deal in with shares and other interest or in obligations of other domestic or foreign corporation, whether for profit or not, associations, and partnerships or individuals, or direct or indirect of the United States, or of any other government, state, territory, governmental, district, municipality, or any instrumentality thereof.
