



REDEMPTION CHURCH OF LAKELAND, INC.

(A Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation)

Adopted and Effective: December 21, 2023

These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of REDEMPTION CHURCH OF LAKELAND, INC., a Florida not-for-profit corporation (the "Corporation"), dated and effective as of December 21 2023, are being duly executed and filed to amend, completely restate, and supersede the Corporation's Articles of Incorporation, which were originally filed and effective as of April 27, 2015 (Document No. N15000004366).

Article I NAME

The name of this corporation shall be REDEMPTION CHURCH OF LAKELAND, INCORPORATED (hereinafter called the "Corporation").

Article II PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The address of the principal office and the mailing address of the Corporation is 145 E. Edgewood Dr., Lakeland, FL 33803.

Article III COMMENCEMENT OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

The Corporation shall commence its existence as of the date of filing for incorporation with the Florida Secretary of State and shall have perpetual existence unless sooner dissolved according to law.

Article IV PURPOSES

The general purpose of this Corporation shall be to operate exclusively for religious, charitable, educational, scientific, or literary purposes, and in furtherance of such goals is authorized to do any and all activities which it is empowered to do under these Articles provided, however, that nothing herein shall be construed as allowing any activities which would jeopardize the Corporation's tax-exempt status or otherwise be inconsistent with its classification as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended or replaced from time to time (the "Code") and its regulations as they now exist or may hereafter be amended, or as a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

The specific purpose for which the Corporation is formed is to make Jesus Christ known to every man, woman, and child of the greater Lakeland area, and the world, through the Church.

Article V GENERAL POWERS

This Corporation shall have all the powers enumerated for corporations in the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act, as it now exists and as hereafter amended, and all such other powers as are permitted by applicable law, including, without limitation and only by illustration, the following powers unless later restricted by applicable law:

- A. To have succession by its corporate name for the duration of its existence.
- B. To sue and be sued and appear and defend in all actions and proceedings in its corporate name to the same extent as a natural person.
- C. To purchase, take, receive, lease, take by gift, devise, or bequest or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use, and otherwise deal in and with real or personal property or any interest therein, wherever situated.
- D. To sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, create security interests in, lease, exchange, transfer, and otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets.
- E. To lend money for its corporate purposes, invest and reinvest its funds, and take and hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned or invested.
- F. To make donations for the public welfare or for religious, charitable, scientific, educational, or other similar purposes.
- G. To increase, as the Bylaws may direct, the number of its directors, so that the number shall not be less than three but may be any number in excess thereof.
- H. To conduct its affairs, carry on its operations, and have offices and exercise the powers granted by the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act in any state, territory, district, or possession of the United States or any foreign country.
 - I. To elect or appoint officers and agents and define their duties.
- J. To adopt, change, amend and repeal Bylaws, not inconsistent with these Articles of Incorporation or with the laws of the State of Florida, for the administration and regulation of its affairs and the exercise of its powers.
 - K. To have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to affect its purposes.

Article VI ELDER BOARD

- A. <u>Powers</u>. The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed under the direction of the Board of Directors, which shall be referred to as the "Elder Board." The directors serving on the Elder Board shall be referred to as the "Elders." The Elder Board shall have the powers necessary or appropriate for the administration of the affairs of the Corporation. The authority of the Elder Board shall be subject to the Bylaws and those powers granted to the Members therein.
- B. <u>Number</u>. The number of Elders serving on the Elder Board shall be determined from time to time in accordance with the Bylaws, but shall never be less than three (3).
- C. <u>Election; Removal; Resignation</u>. The manner of election, removal and resignation of Elders shall be regulated by the Bylaws.

Article VII REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The name and Florida address of the registered agent of the Corporation is Brannen Padgett, 413 Patten Heights St., Fl 33803.

Article VIII MEMBERSHIP

This corporation shall have Members, with such powers and obligations as set forth in the Bylaws.

Article IX **DEDICATION OF ASSETS AND DISSOLUTION**

The Corporation's assets are irrevocably dedicated to its public benefit purposes. Upon dissolution of this Corporation, all properties and assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the Corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation that is organized exclusively for religious and charitable purposes, pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding provision in any future tax code or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so

disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively, as said court shall determine, for such purposes or to such organization or organizations which are organized and operated exclusively for religious and charitable purposes, pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding provision in any future tax code.

Article X PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

No part of the net earnings or distribution of the assets of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its officers, members, trustees, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments in furtherance of the purposes of the Corporation set forth herein. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article XI AMENDMENT

These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation may be amended at any time by a vote of a majority of the Elders present at any regular or special meeting provided a quorum is present, or through unanimous written consent to the extent allowable under Florida law.
