ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

Article I

Name

The name of the corporation shall be KYLE JUTRAS SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION, INC.

Article II

Principal Office and Mailing Address

The principal place of business and the mailing address of the Corporation, located in Sarasota County, Florida, shall be: Kyle Jutras Scholarship Foundation, Inc., 6471 Woodbirch Place, Sarasota, Florida 34238

Article III

Purpose

The specific purposes for which this Corporation is organized are: to provide financial assistance via scholarships to high school graduates from Sarasota, Manatee or Charlotte Counties, who are seeking an undergraduate degree at an accredited educational institution. Selection criteria and application requirements will be set forth in the bylaws of the Corporation. This Corporation is organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

Article IV

Board of Directors and Manner of Election

The affairs of the Corporation and all of its property shall be directed by a Board of Directors numbering not fewer than four (4) elected directors nor more than seven (7) elected directors. The Board of Directors shall be elected as set forth in the Corporation's bylaws.

Article VI

Members

This Corporation shall have no members.

Article VII

Restrictions

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The property of this Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to educational purposes. Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this Corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

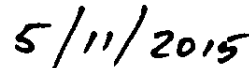

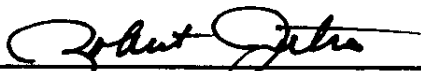

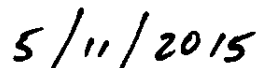
