### Purpose

1. Purpose. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future federal law. Such purposes include but are not limited to:-

- (f) Use the much needed skill of coding to connect Africans with the rest of the world in order to challenge prejudice and reduce hatred and to use that power to encourage people to embrace positive attitudes, personal responsibility, and respect for others
- (g) Ensure the economic prosperity of Africans and communities across the globe whilst equipping Africans with tools for innovation and social change
- (h) Expose more Africans to computer science at a young age in order to give them more opportunities and financial independence whilst they work
- (i) Help to facilitate a platform where a new wave of Africans will stay in Africa and create revolutionary ideas for the benefit of Africa
- (j) Build on the network Africans Who Code has developed with leading educators, engineers, and entrepreneurs by providing additional mentorship programs and exposure in the fields of computer science education, web design, and mobile development
