ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF VETERANS' MEMORIAL AT HARBOURSIDE PLACE, INC.

TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1 NAME

The name of the corporation is Veterans' Memorial at Harbourside Place, Inc. The corporation is organized under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation is:

115 Front Street Suite 300 Jupiter, FL 33477

ARTICLE III PURPOSES

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To receive or maintain a fund or funds of real or personal property, or both, and, subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the whole or any part of the income derived therefrom and the principal thereof exclusively for charitable, literary, scientific and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations, as same now exist or as they may hereafter be amended (the "Code").

To conduct fund raising activities and to use and apply the net funds raised therefrom exclusively for charitable, literary, scientific and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and its Regulations, as same now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

ARTICLE IV DIRECTORS

The manner of election or appointment of the directors of the corporation is set forth in the bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE V LIMITATIONS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, officer of the corporation or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes). No member, director, officer of the corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except as otherwise may be permitted in Section 501(h) of the Code. The corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not conduct or carry on activities that are not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or by any organization, as to which contributions to such organization are deductible under Section 170(c) (2) of the Code.

The operation of this corporation shall be exclusively for charitable, literary, scientific and educational purposes in the public interest. The corporation shall not be operated for the benefit of private interests, the creators of the corporation or their families, or shareholders, or persons controlled by the creators or their families.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation or the winding up of its affairs, the assets of the corporation shall be distributed exclusively to charitable organizations which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or to the federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose.

As a means of accomplishing the corporate purposes, the corporation shall have all the general powers set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes and as said Chapter hereafter may be amended. The general powers available to the corporation shall be exercised exclusively for the attainment of the charitable, literary, scientific and educational purposes of the corporation, as set forth in this Article.

ARTICLE VI REGISTERED AGENT
