Florida Urban Homesteading Incorporated is a non-profit corporation and shall operate exclusively for advocacy, educational and charitable purpose

We provide education by giving free lectures, video tutorial learning series, and farm tours as well as utilizing social media channels and the corporation's website to provide facts, statistics, and other related data on causes, current efforts and solutions to member and public questions as it relates but not limited to homesteading and homesteading activities.

Our programs include sponsoring local farmers and homesteaders to provide education to low income familes, teaching them the skills they need to raise their own food and feed themselves and their families. Our goal is to build facilities dedicated to teaching and outreach as well as hosting community gardens, conducting research, and dissemnating information to the community. We plan on working with the state and local beekeepers to increase the number of bees and beekeepers in the state of Florida. We will sponser FFA and 4H chapters throughout the state as funds permit as well as reach out to disabled veteran programs to offer support and opportunites as they present themselves.

To maximize our impact on current efforts, we may seek to collaborate with other non-profit organizations as well as City, County, and State departments where our interests coincide with one another.

At times, per the discretion of the board of directors, we may provide internships or volunteer opportunities which will provide opportunities for involvement in said activities and programs in order to have a greater impact for change.

Upon termination or dissolution of Florida Urban Homesteading Incorporated, any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one (1) or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or described in any corresponding provision of any successor statute) which organization or organizations have a charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation.

The organization to receive the assets of Florida Urban Homesteading Incorporated hereunder shall be selected by the discretion of a majority of the managing body of Florida Urban Homesteading Incorporated and if its members cannot so agree, then the recipient organization shall be selected pursuant to a verified petition in equity filed in a court of proper jurisdiction against Florida Urban Homesteading Incorporated by one (1) or more of its managing body which verified petition shall contain such statements as reasonably indicate the applicability of this section. The court upon a finding that this section is applicable shall select the qualifying organization or organizations to receive the assets to be distributed, giving preference if practicable to organizations located within the State of Florida.

No part of the net earnings, or properties of this corporation, on dissolution or otherwise, shall

inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private person or individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III, Section 3.01.
