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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

In compliance with the requirements of Florida Statutes, Chapter 617, the undersigned serves as incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation not-for-profit and does hereby certify:

ARTICLE I NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the corporation is Loggerhead Aquatic Swim Team, Inc. (hereinafter called the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE CORPORATION

The principal office and mailing address of the Corporation shall be 1009 St Julien Ct., St. Johns, Florida 32259.

ARTICLE III REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 11380 Prosperity Farms Road #221E, Palm Beach Gardens, Florida 33410. The name of the initial registered agent at that address is Corporate Creations International, Inc.

ARTICLE (V PURPOSES AND POWERS OF THE CORPORATION

This Corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to its members, and the specific purposes for which it is formed are:

- (1) exclusively for charitable and educational purposes and to foster national and international sports competition in the sport of swimming, all within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or under any corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws governing the distributions to organizations qualified as tax-exempt; and
- (2) except as limited by the Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws, the Corporation will have and exercise all rights and powers in furtherance of its purposes as are or may hereafter be conferred on not for profit corporations pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and in accordance with other applicable law.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from

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Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE V MEMBERSHIP

This Corporation shall not have members.

ARTICLE VI BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The affairs of this Corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors. The method of election or appointment of the Board of Directors shall be fixed and governed by the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VII DISSOLUTION

A majority of the Board of Directors may authorize dissolution of the Corporation. After dissolution is authorized, the Corporation must file articles of dissolution, in compliance with Section 617.1403, Florida Statutes, with the Department of State.

Upon the dissolution or winding up of this Corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the Corporation, shall be distributed to a not for profit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

ARTICLE VIII DURATION

The Corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE IX AMENDMENTS

A majority vote of the Board of Directors may amend the Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE X BYLAWS

The Bylaws of this Corporation shall be adopted by the incorporator on behalf of the Corporation and may be altered, amended, or rescinded by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.
