# **ARTICLE I**

Corporation Name:



# **ARTICLE III**

Purpose of the Corporation:

The purpose of the corporation is to clean up, restore and preserve the springs, rivers, lakes, estuaries, bays and shallow coastal waters in Citrus County, Florida. This includes the removal of lyngbya, chaetomorpha, and other detrimental aquatic materials polluting areas including, but not limited to, Kings Bay and Crystal River Basin, in order to make the area a more hospitable habitat for marine life and to create a more enjoyable recreational environment for citizens and visitors. It shall also educate the public about how to be proactive in maintaining the health of such aquatic resources, and shall provide a model and resource for other groups to facilitate the cleaning up and restoration of waterways in other locations.

One Rake at a Time, Inc. will perform as a charitable origination that lightens the burden on governmental bodies



and contributes to the social welfare of the community by cleaning, restoring and preserving these water ways.

The corporation will also conduct such other activities and programs in furtherance of the foregoing purposes as may be carried out by a corporation organized under Florida Statutes, Chapter 617, and as described in Section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

# ARTICLE IV

#### Manner of Election:

A nominating committee shall be appointed by the president to present a slate of officers and directors. At the annual meeting, the directors then in office shall vote on the slate as presented. Upon a vote by two thirds of a quorum of the sitting board members at the annual meeting, additional candidates for either officers or directors may also be placed on the ballot for a vote in opposition to any candidates proposed by the nominating committee. A majority of the votes of the quorum of the board is required for the election of a new officer or director.
