Article I - Name

The name of this non-profit corporation will be LITERACY MATTERS INC.

Article II – Principal Office

The principal address is 18316 Cypress Bay Parkway, Land O Lakes, Fl. 34638

Article III - Purpose

LITERACY MATTERS INC. is to be a non-profit corporation formed under Florida Statute 617 and organized exclusively for charitable purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
