ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE HYPPOLITE FOUNDATION, INC.

We, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves for the purpose of becoming a non-for-profit Corporation under the laws of the state of Florida and are therefore bound by State Statutes regulating information, liability, rights privileges and immunities of a not-for-profit Corporation.

ARTICLE 1 Name of Corporation

The name of the Corporation Is THE HYPPOLITE FOUNDATION, INC

ARTICLE 11 **Purpose**

This Corporation is organized to promote education as a tool that empowers people, communities and nations. Besides promoting education, the Foundation will support financially individuals and organizations that are seeking to break the perpetuating cycle of ignorance and poverty through Education and Training.

In the pursuit of this goal, the Corporation can acquire, buy, hold, own, sell, exchange, convey, lease or otherwise dispose of goods, chattels, effects and merchandise. In can Also mortgage, lease hypothecate convey, exchange and dispose of lands and chattels. It may enter any transactions deemed lawful authorized by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE 111 Corporate Existence

This Corporation shall exist for a perpetual period of time. It shall have offices throughout and outside the State of Florida.

ARTICLE 1V By-Laws

By-laws of the corporation are to be made offered and rescinded by a majority of the qualified members of the organization, present and voting at a regular or special business meeting.

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ARTICLE V Principal Place of Business

ARTICLE V1 Dissolution

In the event of dissolution, the remaining or residual assets of THE HYPPOLITE FOUNDATION INC shall be transferred to a not-for-profit organization qualified and in good standing under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Codes.

ARTICLE V11 Prohibited Activities

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this corporation shall carry out only activities permitted by (a) a corporation exempt from Federal Tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provisions of any future United State Internal Revenue Law or (b) a corporation's contribution which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal revenue Code of 1954 or any other corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE V111 Initial Board of Directors

Initially, this corporation shall have three directors. The number may increase depending on the business needs; bur may never be less than one. The directors shall hold office for the first year of existence of the corporation and until their successors are elected or appointed according to the By-Laws.
