ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned incorporator, for the purposes of forming a Florida not-for-profit corporation, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The Name of the Corporation is:

ARTICLE II - ADDRESS

ARTICLE III - SPECIFIC PURPOSE

Martial Arts for Life Foundation, Inc., is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, including, for such purposes, providing an environment to learn about and engage in martial arts for underprivileged and at risk youth in the Tampa Bay Area, and raising funds to support such martial arts related activities, and the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, and are dedicated to such purposes as stated above. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

ARTICLE IV - EXEMPTION REQUIREMENTS

At all times shall the following operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the Corporation:

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1. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

2. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this document, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

3. The Corporation is not organized and shall not be operated for the private gain of any person. The property of the Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its charitable purposes. No part of the receipts, or net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to any individual. The Corporation may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles.

ARTICLE V - DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of by the Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VI - BOARD OF DIRECTORS MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which directors are elected or appointed shall be as provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VII - INITIAL DIRECTORS & OFFICERS

The Corporation shall have no members. The management of the affairs of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors, as defined in the Corporation's Bylaws. No Director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the Corporation. 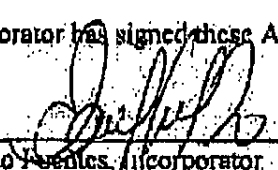

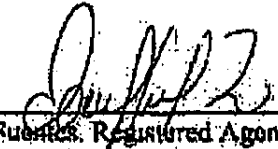
