ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION HEAR FOR GOOD, INC.

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., the following articles designate the formation of a not-for-profit corporation under Florida Law:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Hear for Good, Inc., referred to herein as the "Corporation."

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal street address and mailing address of the Corporation shall be: 1230 NW 133rd Ave.
Sunrise, FL 33323

ARTICLE III: PURPOSES

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Specifically, the Corporation is organized to ensure that hearing impaired adults and children have access to high-quality audiologic care, including but not limited to hearing instruments and services, regardless of economic status or insurance coverage.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV: ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The Corporation shall not have members. All corporate powers shall be exercised by the Board of Directors, the initial four of whom are named below. Directors shall hold office for a term of two years, at which time each board member shall nominate a successor during the annual board meeting. Self-nominations are permitted. Each nomination shall be confirmed by majority vote of the remaining directors. If, prior to the end of the term, a director resigns, becomes incapacitated, or is removed from office by majority vote of the Board, any other board member may nominate a successor. The appointment shall be confirmed by majority vote of the Board during a special meeting held for such purpose.

Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
