ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE HOWARD W. BLAKE ACADEMIC FOUNDATION, INCORPORATED

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a non-profit corporation in accordance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, do hereby submit these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation.

ARTICLE 1 Name/Duration

The name of the corporation shall be The Howard W. Blake Academic Foundation, Incorporated. The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE 2 Principal Office

The place in Florida where the principal office of the Corporation shall be located is 1701 North Boulevard, Tampa, Florida 33607.

ARTICLE 3 Purpose of Corporation
