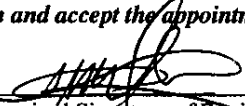

Denomination - Main Office – Purpose

Art. 1.- It has been created a nonprofit apolitical organization, with philanthropic character, called "Caring & Sharing Vision", whose acronym is CSV.

Art. 2.- CSV main office is located at 714 SW 1st ST Fort Lauderdale, FL 33304. When necessary, we will establish subsidiaries in other States in America and worldwide.

Art. 3.- The purpose for which the corporation exists is to create an environment that encourages young people and adults to reach their full potential. In addition, this corporation will be educational, philanthropic, civic, and moral. It will collaborate with many churches in order to support children and adults to live a life according to God's laws. An education program will be established to train instructors and tutors. Finally, it will provide the necessary health care as well as nutrition.

Members

Art. 4.- Caring & Sharing Vision consists of:

- Founding Members
- Adherent Members
- Honorary Members

Art. 5.- Founding members are those who funded CSV, and signed the Constitution of the Organization.

Art. 6.- Adherent or associate members are people of good will who show interest and commitment to the statutes and regulations of the Organization.

Art. 7.- Honorary members are individuals or legal entities that provide support to the Organization and have been recognized as such by the Board of Directors.

Art. 8.- The status of CSV member is lost:

- By death
- By resignation
- By unjustified prolonged absence

- By expulsion by the Executive Committee with a majority of two thirds (2/3) for serious reasons determined by internal regulations.

Financial Resources

Art. 9.- CSV Resources come from several sources:

- Monthly membership fees
- Fundraising
- Any gifts, bequests, grants from natural or legal person(s), national or international institutions.

Manner of Election

Art. 10.- The members of the Executive Board are elected for four years by a majority vote and may be re-elected by the general meeting.

Administration

Art. 11.- CSV is administered by a board composed of nine members:

- President
- Vice President
- General Secretary
- Assistant Secretary
- Accountant (Treasurer)
- Public Relations 1
- Public Relations 2
- Counselor 1
- Counselor 2
- Counselor 3

Art. 12.- The Board has the powers to act on behalf of CSV and take all decisions related to the administration and management activities.

Officers Responsibilities

Art. 13.- The President of the Executive Board is responsible for the general management of the Organization activities, and must conduct current business in accordance to the goods of the organization.

Art. 14.- He presides at all meetings of the Executive Board, and shall ensure that all decisions and resolutions taken are applied; he signs agreements and contracts ratified by the Board, oversees all projects of the organization and shall ensure that all contractors fulfill their obligation properly.

Art. 15.- He represents the organizations in all acts of civil life. In case of absence or impediment, he is replaced by the Vice President of the Board. The Vice President holds the same powers.

Art. 16.- The General Secretary is responsible for keeping records, minutes and corporate records. He drafted the proceeding records of the Board meeting and ensures, in the shortest period, transcription on register intended for this purpose.

Art. 17.- He shall ensure that notices are made according to standards.

Art. 18.- The Treasurer ensures the financial management of the organization. He is responsible for CSV expenses, authorized by the Board after sound justification. He signed with the President or Vice President checks and all documents relating to cash money.

Art. 19.- Public Relations (PR) are about managing reputations. A public relation officer tries to influence opinion and behavior. Their responsibilities are to:

- Communicate key messages
- Establish and maintain good will
- Discover concerns and expectations
- Report and explain the findings to the management
- Plan, develop, and implement PR strategies
- Source and manage speaking and sponsorship opportunities

The Executive Council Meeting

Art. 20 .- The Executive Board meets regularly once a month; it may also be convened at the extraordinary demand of the President or Vice President and in special session on the written request of two members.

Art. 21.- The Executive Board takes by simple majority vote. Any decision must meet an absolute vote to be valid.

Art. 22.- The deliberations of the council and its resolutions shall be recorded in the minutes signed by all the members who have participated, and be compiled in a special register.

Art. 23.- The General Meeting represents the sovereign will of CSV. It is composed of at least two thirds (2/3) of the founding members and adherents. On the occasion of such sessions, each member has one vote.

Contents of Heritage

Art. 24.- The Organization's assets consist of real and buildings necessary for the smooth operation for the management, monitoring and evaluation of project activities implemented for the benefit of the population.

Art. 25.- In no case, the Organization's assets may not be assigned, in whole or in part, to members as income.

Art. 26.- The rules of procedure set out the modalities of liquidation of assets in the event of termination of the Organizations timekeeping.

Dissolution- Liquidation





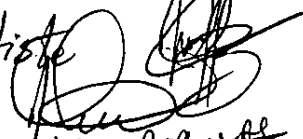

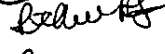

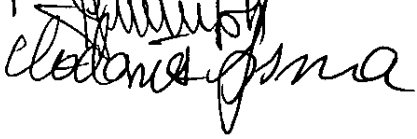
Art. 27.- CSV may be dissolved in case it becomes impossible to follow its goals and objectives or for any other reason provided by law.

Art. 28.- In case of voluntary or involuntary dissolution, the Extraordinary General Meeting is charged to ensure the liquidation; one or several members of the Organization will be invested with the necessary powers for this purpose.

Art. 29.- The voluntary dissolution of the organization may be imposed in the event of a merger with one or more other Non-Profit Organizations, Development Assistance, or by unanimous decision of the Founding Members, voted by the General Assembly in the extraordinary. In the latter case, the decision must be passed by a majority of two thirds (2/3) of participants.

Art. 30.- The liquidation proceeds, after payment of liabilities will be given to any private organization with similar objectives to those of the CSV.

Art. 31.- The Founding Members of the Organization: Caring & Sharing Vision (CSV) approved the present status.
