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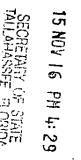

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

Marco Island Paddlers Association Incorporated

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose of the Association, which is organized exclusively for nonprofit public benefit, shall be to serve as a local forum for all paddlers, addressing their needs and promoting the benefits of kayaking and other paddle activities as lifetime recreational and healthful activities through:

Section 3.1: - COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT - to increase the understanding and appreciation of kayaking and other paddle activities by developing a community of paddlers that: participate in group paddles, attend social activities, assist in community-sponsored events, and model healthful and environmentally-friendly paddling behavior.

Section 3.2 - SAFETY, EDUCATION, AND INSTRUCTION – to develop and implement safety education, and instruction programs designed to introduce, inform, and train paddlers of all skill levels in all aspects and areas of kayaking and other paddle sports.

Section 3.3 - RECREATION AND ATHLETIC CHALLENGES – to develop and implement programs designed to foster cordiality while meeting the health and fitness needs of individuals or organizations engaged in both competitive and non-competitive aspects of kayaking and other paddle activities.

Section 3.4 - CONSERVATION AND PUBLIC POLICY — to develop and implement programs designed to protect our natural environment, promote the low impact use of our natural resources, and promote protecting the rights of all paddlers to use and access our rivers, estuaries, mangrove and coastal waters.
