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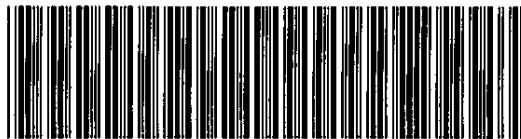

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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ARTICLE I NAME

The Name of the corporation shall be **Bahamas Revisited Community Inc.** a Not for profit Florida Corporation.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes as specified in Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to raise and disburse funds in order to support ongoing environmental, educational and conservation efforts in The Bahamas. These efforts include the education of Bahamian youth about their heritage, culture and environment, enhancing their awareness of the need for preservation of natural resources.

The corporation shall seek grants from other funding sources and donations from the public in order to support its primary activities. These fundraising activities will allow it to provide much needed resources and support to other entities worldwide that are focused on environmental and conservation efforts, with particular emphasis on education.

The corporation shall accept gifts, donations and endowments, and make gifts, donations and endowments for or to any charitable, scientific or educational undertaking, organization, institution or purpose anywhere in the world that meets the tax-exempt requirements of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Bahamas Revisited Community Inc. Articles of Incorporation

The corporation may seek to collaborate with other non-profit organizations that qualify under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and are operated exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes.

The corporation may, at some point in the future, establish its own programs and services within or without the United States, fulfilling the above stated missions directly and in keeping with its commitment to function as a charitable entity falling under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE IV NON-PROFIT NATURE

Bahamas Revisited Community Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable, scientific, and educational purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code. No part of the net earnings of Bahamas Revisited Community Inc. shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by any organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Bahamas Revisited Community Inc. is not organized and shall not be operated for the private gain of any person. The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its educational, scientific and charitable purposes. No part of the assets, receipts, or net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to any individual. The corporation may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles.

ARTICLE V MANNER OF ELECTION

Directors shall be appointed or elected as indicated in the bylaws of the corporation.


