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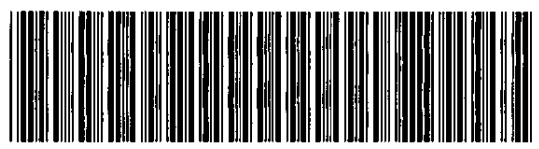

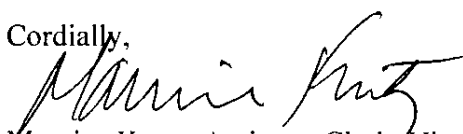

CHARTER OF RELIGIOUS SOCIETY

We, the undersigned, respectfully present to your Honor the following proposed charter for a religious society and respectfully request your Honor to approve the charter and to endorse your approval thereon.

CHARTER OF ST. PETERSBURG
MEETING OF THE RELIGIOUS
SOCIETY OF FRIENDS, INC.

I.

The name of the corporation is "St. Petersburg Meeting of the Religious Society of Friends, Inc." and it is to be located in St. Petersburg, Pinellas County, State of Florida.

II.

The general nature of the object of the corporation is to provide a place or places of worship and meeting for members of the St. Petersburg Meeting of the Religious Society of Friends, or its successors.

III.

All members in good standing of the St. Petersburg Meeting of the Religious Society of Friends, or its successors, shall be members of the corporation, subject to such rules and regulations as the corporation may prescribe in its By-laws.

IV.

This corporation is to have perpetual existence.

V.

The names and residences of the subscribers to the corporation are as follows:

VI.

The affairs of the corporation are to be managed by a President, Vice-President and Secretary, and Treasurer. The Clerk of the St. Petersburg Meeting of the Religious Society of Friends, or its successors, shall be the President of the corporation; the assistant Clerk of the St. Petersburg Meeting of the Religious Society of Friends, or its successors, shall be the Vice-President and Secretary of the corporation; and the Treasurer of the St. Petersburg Meeting of the Religious Society of Friends, or its successors, shall be the Treasurer of the corporation. These three officers shall constitute the Board of Directors of the corporation and shall be elected at the annual meeting of the corporation to be held at such time in January of each year as the By-laws may provide.

VII.

VIII.

The By-laws of the corporation are to be made by the Directors of the corporation, but may be altered or rescinded at any meeting of the corporation by the consensus of opinion of the members present.

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which the corporation may at any time subject itself shall be Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars.

X.

The amount in value of the real estate which the corporation may hold shall be Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars.
