ARTICLE IX:

Sarasota Islamic Academy, Inc. (the "Corporation") is organized exclusively for educational religious, and charitable purposes as specified in section 501(c) (3) of the internal Revenue Code, and shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Code Section 501 (c) (3).

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on or propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the Corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes, as specified in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws and shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization(s) organized and operated exclusively for educational religious, and charitable purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization(s) under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
