ARTICLE I

1.01 Name

The name of this corporation is **The Simone Brewton Foundation**. The business of the corporation may be conducted as (The Simone Foundation or other names)

ARTICLE II

DURATION

2.01 Duration

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

3.01 Registered Office

The principal <u>street</u> address and <u>mailing address</u> is 1340 East Golfview Drive, Pembroke Pines, FL 33026

ARTICLE IV

PURPOSE

4.01 Purpose

The corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and shall operate exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

The Specific purposes for which corporation is organized include, but are not limited to: preservation and management of the foundation, and delivery of programs for educational, scientific, and for developing financial resources so as to provide financial assistance, education, support, comfort and aid, to individuals and their families who face enormous medical, transportation, and living accommodations expenses for medical treatments such as organ transplants etc.

 We provide education by giving free lectures and slideshows on trending medical surgeries in schools, libraries, and other public venues as well as utilizing social media channels and the

corporation's website to provide facts, statistics and other related data on causes, current efforts and solutions to eradicating chronic diseases.

- Our programs will include sending out ambassadors to raise social consciousness about causes on a local and global level, and to hold fundraising events in order to provide immediate relief and assistance to those who are in critical regardless of race, ethnicity or religion.
- To maximize our impact on current efforts, we may seek to collaborate with other nonprofit
 organizations which fall under Section 501(c)(3) of the internal revenue code and are operated
 exclusively for educational and charitable purposes.
- At times, per the discretion of our board of directors, we may provide internship or volunteer
 opportunities which will provide opportunities for involvement in said activities and programs in
 order to have a greater impact.

4.02 Public Benefit

The Simone Brewton Foundation is designated a public benefit corporation.

ARTICLE V

PRIVATE FOUNDATION

5.01 Private Foundation

Notwithstanding any other provisions in these articles, at all times as a private foundation within the meaning of Section 509 of the Code it shall be subject to the following restrictions:

The corporation shall (a) distribute its income for each tax year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code; (b) shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code; (c) shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943 (c) of the Code; (d) shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Code; (e) shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945 (d) of the Code.

ARTICLE VI NON-PROFIT NATURE

6.01 Non-Profit Nature

The Simone Brewton Foundation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal code. No earnings of The Simone Brewton Foundation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its directors, officers, trustees or other private persons, except that the corporation be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause thereof.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by any organization exempt from federal tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or (b) an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

The Simone Brewton Foundation is not organized and shall not be operated for the private gain of any one person. The property of the organization is irrevocably dedicated to its charitable and educational purposes. No part of its assets, receipts, or net profits of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or distributed to any individual. The corporation may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles.

6.02 Person Liability

No officer or director shall be personally responsible for the debts and obligations of The Simone Brewton Foundation, of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property or assets of the officers or directors be subject to the payment of debts or obligation of this corporation.

6.03 Restricted Activities

No substantial part of the corporation's activities shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene (including the publishing or distribution of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

6.05 Prohibited Activities

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by (I) any corporation exempt from federal income tax as described under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or (II) or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

ARTICLE VII

MEMBERS

7.01 Members

The Simone Brewton Foundation shall have no members. The management of the affairs of the corporation shall be vested in the board of directors, as defined in the corporation's By-Laws.

ARTICLE VIII

MANNER OF ELECTION

8.01 Manner of Election

The initial directors of the corporation shall be appointed and all other directors will be elected to serve two-year terms in office as determined by the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLES X DISSOLUTION

10.01 Dissolution

Upon termination or dissolution of this corporation, any assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to one (1) or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future

federal tax Code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. The organization to receive the assets of The Simone Brewton Foundation hereunder shall be selected by the discretion of a majority of the managing body of the corporation, and if its members cannot so agree, then the recipient organization shall be selected pursuant to a verified petition in equity filed in a court of proper jurisdiction against the foundation by one or more of its managing body. The court upon a finding that this section is applicable shall select the qualifying organization or organizations to receive the assets to be distributed, giving preference to organizations within the state of Florida.

In the event that the court shall find that this section is applicable but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has a charitable purpose, which at least generally, includes a purpose similar to this corporation, then the court shall direct the distribution of its assets lawfully available for distribution to the Treasurer of the State of Florida to be added to the general fund.

ARTICLE XI AMENDMENTS

11.01 Amendments

Any amendment to the Articles of Incorporation may be adopted by approval of two-thirds (2/3) of the board of directors.
