ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this corporation is **INTERNATIONAL SPORTS COMPLEX & ACADEMY, INC.**

ARTICLE II ADDRESS

The initial street address of the principal office of the corporation is: 13054 Hatherton Circle, Orlando, Florida 32832. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the principal office to any other address.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The corporation is committed to excellence in academic and athletic development. The mission of the corporation is to offer a safe, secure, nurturing environment for girls and boys requiring augmentation to their current academic and/or athletic endeavors. The corporation shall provide structured academic and athletic programs for participating student-athletes. Individual development activities are designed to challenge student-athletes and encourage those who may be underachieving or who are experiencing difficulties. It is the corporation's goal to provide deserving student-athletes the opportunity to realize their full potential utilizing a holistic approach combining academics & athletics.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section

501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federaltax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected and appointed is set forth in the bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE V DIRECTORS

The business and affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors consisting of not less than three (3) persons. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by the bylaws, but in no event shall the number of directors be less than three (3).
