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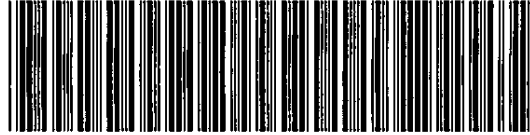



(NOT FOR PROFIT)

The subscribers hereto do hereby associate themselves together for the purpose of becoming incorporated under and in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida as a Corporation, not for profit, and for that purpose do hereby propose the following charter:

FIRST

The name of this Corporation shall be the TUESDAY MUSIC CLUB domiciled at Lakeland, Polk County, Florida.

SECOND

The general nature and object of this corporation is to foster and promote music and music interests, and to encourage in the home and community an appreciation of good music; to build and maintain a Club House, and for that purpose shall have the power to purchase, rent, lease or otherwise acquire, hold, own, lease, mortgage, improve, sell or otherwise dispose of any and every kind or kinds of real estate and personal property necessary to carry out the object of this corporation.

THIRD

The membership of this TUESDAY MUSIC CLUB shall be of three classes, ACTIVE, ASSOCIATE and HONORARY; Active members shall be those who take part in the program; Associate members shall have the privilege of attending all meetings but not the right to vote or to take part

on the program, or perform any of the Club duties; honorary members shall be those persons distinguished for service to the Club or to the cause of Music, and must be elected by a unanimous vote of the Club. All other members shall be elected by the Club but in case as many as three votes are cast against an applicant for membership, the said applicant shall be rejected. Active and Associate members shall pay such dues and at such times as may be required by the By-Laws of this Corporation.

#### FOURTH

This Corporation shall exist for a period of One Hundred (100) years unless dissolved in the manner prescribed by law.
