**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of
ALBERT FAMILY FOUNDATION, INC.**

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - CORPORATE NAME

The name of the corporation is Albert Family Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The corporation shall exist perpetually unless dissolved according to Florida law.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The corporation is organized for the purpose of engaging in various charitable activities, as described in Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3). No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its shareholders, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the charitable purposes of the Corporation. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Internal Revenue Code Section 170(c)(2).

ARTICLE IV – MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed shall be stated in the corporation's bylaws.

The Corporation will not make any taxable expenditure as defined in Internal Revenue Code Section 4945(d) or the corresponding section of any future tax code.






