ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I: NAME

1.1: The name of the corporation shall be Gainesville Modern, Incorporated.

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE

2.1: The street address of the corporation shall be 3131 NW 13th Street Suite 42, Gainesville, FL 32609.

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

3.1: Gainesville Modern, Inc., (hereinafter Gainesville Modern) partnered with Historic Gainesville, Inc., for many years, working to preserve the modern architectural heritage of Gainesville and Alachua County. However, as Gainesville Modern's mission has grown, it now makes sense to charter an independent 501(c)(3) corporation, so that we might more effectively pursue our dedication to spreading awareness of Gainesville's modern architecture.

To carry out our mission of advocacy and education, Gainesville Modern holds an annual house tour, showcasing some of the many immaculate modern homes in the area, as well as events and meetings throughout the year. Additionally, Gainesville Modern sponsors workshops for homeowners interested in architectural preservation and home maintenance of their modern property. As interest in modern architecture expands, Gainesville Modern will expand with it to provide resources and programming to serve the community.

Gainesville Modern is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the Statement of Purpose. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to education about and preservation of the modern architectural heritage of Gainesville, FL, and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

ARTICLE IV: MANNER OF ELECTION
