

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

16 FEB 12 PH 2: 25

PLAZA DE ADORACION PARA LA FAMILIA, INC.

The undersigned Incorporator, being a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation not for profit under the "Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act," Chapter 617, Fla.Stats., as follows:

Article I - Name

The name of the corporation shall be Plaza de Adoracion Para La Familia, Inc.

Article II - Principal Office

The principal street address and mailing address of the corporation is

1260 N.W. 29th Street Miami, Florida 33142

Article III - Purpose

- 1. The purpose of the corporation is to serve the community as a Christian outreach ministry by spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ through education and discipleship, and otherwise by performing all activities generally conducted by a religious outreach ministry.
- 2. In furtherance of its purpose, the corporation may solicit funds and donations; acquire and receive by purchase, donation or otherwise, any real or personal, or mixed property, to hold, use, or dispose of; borrow money, including by securing loans by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust or other similar lien; apply for, obtain, and contract with any federal, state, or local government or agency for a direct loan or loans or other financial aid in the form of grants; and engage in any kind of activity, and enter into, perform, and carry out contracts of any kind, necessary or in connection with, or incidental to, the accomplishment of its corporate purpose. The corporation shall use and apply the whole or any part of its income therefrom and the principal thereof exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, literary, or educational purposes either directly or by contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code and Regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

- 3. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 5. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.


