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

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

THE TORNADO STRONG FOOTBALL CLUB, INC. TALL AHASSEE FLORIDA

The undersigned for the purpose of forming a corporation not-for-profit pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I CORPORATE NAME

The name of the corporation is: Tornado Strong Football Club, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business and the mailing address for this corporation shall be: Clearwater High School, 540 S. Hercules Ave., Clearwater, FL 33764.

ARTICLE III **PURPOSE OF ORGANIZING**

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 © 3 of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax codes. This exclusivity of purposes includes the operation to receive, hold, invest and administer property and to make expenditures to or for the benefit of the Football Program at Clearwater High School.

This corporation shall operate as an organization that is supporting by charitable contributions and educational programs, the Football Program at Clearwater High School, a Pinellas County High School in the State of Florida, and not for pecuniary profit, and shall be subject to the Corporations Not for Profit Act, Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE III, Continued PURPOSE OF ORGANIZING

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of these purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or by (b) by a corporation to which contributions are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing upon the filing of these articles.

ARTICLE V MANNER OF ELECTIONS

The manner in which directors are elected and appointed will be regulated as stated in the bylaws. This corporation shall have four (4) Directors initially. The number of Directors may increase or decrease from time to time by the manner prescribed in the bylaws to be adopted by the Directors, but shall never be less than four (4).

ARTICLE VI MEMBERS

The qualification for members, if any, and the manner for their admission will be as stated in the bylaws.

ARTICLE VII NON-STOCK BASIS

This corporation is organized upon a non-stock basis and shall not issue shares of stock.
