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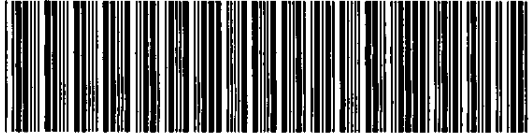

**Article 1.**

The name of the corporation is 7Teen for Girls Inc.

**Article 2.**

The initial registered office of the Corporation shall be at: 2379 SE 19<sup>th</sup> Street, Homestead, FL 33035. The initial registered agent of the Corporation at such address shall be: Rona Scott.

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.  
The specific purpose of the organization is to positively impact the lives of girls ages 12-18 who reside in foster care, group homes or otherwise who cannot live with their families and are under the supervision of a state certified caregiver.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
