

Articles of Incorporation Of

Haven's Women of God in Unity, Inc. (In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., Not for Profit)



Article 1.

The name of the corporation is Haven's Women of God in Unity, Inc.

Article 2.

The initial registered office of the Corporation shall be at: 323 SW Royal Ct, Lake City, FL 32024. The initial registered agent of the Corporation at such address shall be: Fannie Fields.

Article 3.

The name and address of the incorporator is:

Article 4.

The initial principal office address of the Corporation shall be at: 323 SW Royal Ct, Lake City, FL 32024.

Article 5.

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The specific purpose of the organization is to come together to pray, support, mentor, teach, embrace and help build young girls and women lives through expressing love, kindness, patience, respect and compassion.

Article 6.

The Corporation shall have perpetual duration.

Article 7.

Article 8.

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article 9.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
