ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ARNETT CHAPEL AFRICAN METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, INC.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be ARNETT CHAPEL AFRICAN METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, INC.

ARTICLE II

The principal office of this corporation shall be 209 S. DUVAL STREET QUINCY, FL 32351

ARTICLE III

The general nature of the objects and purposes of this corporation shall be:

- A. The Arnett Chapel African Methodist Episcopal Church is organized exclusively for CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL purposes within the meaning of section 501(C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law. This organization is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the NON-PROFIT CHARITABLE AND EDUCATION CORPORATION LAW exclusively for religious, charitable and educational purpose.
- B. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 of the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
- C. The specific purpose of this corporation is to create and enhance educational, social and economic opportunities and development in communities located in Gadsden County, Florida and throughout the state of Florida.
- D. To acquire title to real property and personal property either by purchase, gift or otherwise as owned in fee simple.
- E. To buy, own, hold, contract, improve, mortgage, rent, lease, sell, convey, and otherwise acquire and dispose of real, personal, or mixed property or any rights, interest, or any estate therein as owner or otherwise.
- F. To construct, build, repair, maintain, operate, and lease buildings or other improvements on property owned or controlled by said corporation.
- G. To borrow money and contract debts, issue bonds, promissory notes, bills of exchange, debentures and other obligations and evidence of indebtedness payable at specific time or event, whether secured by mortgage, pledges or otherwise, secured for money borrowed or in payment for property purchased or acquired or any other lawful object or objects.
- H. That the said corporation shall be governed by the By-Laws established by the Corporation and all its property both real and personal shall be subject to these By-

laws, as are now or shall be from time to time be established, made and declared by the lawful authority of the said corporation.

ARTICLE IV

MEMBERSHIP

The membership of this corporation shall constitute all persons hereinafter named as Subscribers and Directors and other persons as from time to hereafter, may become members, in the manner provided in the By-laws of the, African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc.

ARTICLE V

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall manage the business affairs of this corporation. The Board of Directors shall be members of the corporation. Members of the board of Directors shall be elected and hold office in accordance with the By-laws. There shall be at least three but not more than seven Directors.
