Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under the section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The business activity for said organization is as follows: We want to help underprivileged and senior citizens in North America (US and Canada) who are not getting the proper nutrients they need to prevent sickness and death with a plant called Moringa. It is helping to fight malnutrition all over the world. Although there are many non-profits out there that are formed to help combat malnutrition with Moringa, there are none that are helping North Americans (US and Canada) with it. We want to change that. There is just as much malnutrition in North America as there is over seas especially in Senior Citizens and Native American Indians. Our hearts are dedicated to help those individuals who are not getting the proper nutrients. Moringa in powder form is very inexpensive and we can help save peoples lives with just pennies a day. We can also help underprivileged individuals such as Native American Indians to grow and farm their own Moringa trees. We also want to help get the Moringa into elementary schools in poverty stricken areas as Moringa has more Vitamin A than carrots and therefore, helps to prevent blindness. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets remaining shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue

Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
