The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, desiring to form a Not-For-Profit Corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, do hereby accept all of the rights and privileges, benefits and obligations conferred and imposed by said laws and hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation as the Charter of the Corporation hereby organized.

Article I. Corporate Name

Article II. Terms of Existence

This Corporation shall have perpetual Existence.

Article III. Purpose and Powers

Said Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, and educational purposes, including for such purposes the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code. To serve the community-at-large as a safe and secure educational facility conducive for learning experiences as private-not-for-profit school for the education of infants, children, and youth. To present a set of programs, projects, services, classes, seminars, and lectures pertaining to the appropriate age and grade level education of those in which we will serve. To provide but; not be limited to technological, book and by daily experience enhancements, life skills, cultural (music/dance/drama), physical agility, mental agility, field trips, and educational opportunities to further enhance the educational experience. To provide social services to the parents and/or guardians of the children in which we will serve. To provide after school and summer programming, to provide new and more innovative learning experiences through field trips, sporting events, cultural events and through mentoring.

No part of the of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, directors, officers and other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501 (c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be in carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of the Articles, the Corporation shall not carryon any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any further Federal tax code.

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SECRETARY OF STATE DIVISION OF CORPORATIONS Upon dissolution of this Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes with the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any further Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal Government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

There will be no capital stock in this corporation.
