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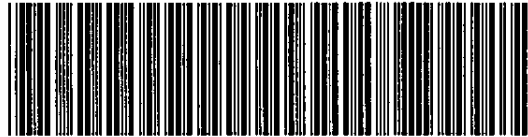

"MINISTERIO COUNT ON ME COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, INC." purpose is to as **described in the main purpose in the Articles of Incorporation section**: We provide education by giving free lectures amongst other things as well as to educate in places accessing areas such as in schools, libraries, and other public venues as well as utilizing social media channels and the corporation's website to provide facts, statistics, and other related data on causes, current efforts and solutions to eradicating chronic malnutrition and hunger. Our programs include sending out ambassadors to raise social consciousness about the cause on a local and global level, and to hold fundraising events in order to provide immediate relief and assistance to those suffering from chronic malnutrition and hunger regardless of their race, ethnicity, or religion. To maximize our impact on current efforts, we may seek to collaborate with other non-profit organizations as well as individuals and For Profit Corporations within the meaning and authorization of the law. Said organizations must fall under the 501(c) (3) section of the internal revenue code and are operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes. At times, per the discretion of the board of directors, or by directions of the President we may provide internships or volunteer opportunities which will provide opportunities for involvement in said activities and programs in order to have a greater impact for change.

"MINISTERIO COUNT ON ME COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, INC." is designated as a public benefit corporation.

Non-profit Nature

"MINISTERIO COUNT ON ME COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, INC." is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. No part of the net earnings of "MINISTERIO COUNT ON ME COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, INC." shall ensure the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services, salaries and commissions as well as gratuities rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by any organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an

Upon termination or dissolution of the "MINISTERIO COUNT ON ME COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, INC.", any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one (1) or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or described in any corresponding provision of any successor statute) which organization or organizations have a charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation.

In the event that the court shall find that this section is applicable but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has a charitable purpose, which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to this corporation, then the court shall direct the distribution of its assets lawfully available for distribution to the Treasurer of "MINISTERIO COUNT ON ME COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, INC." and in the alternative the State of Florida shall be added to the general fund.

Our programs include sending out ambassadors to raise social consciousness about the cost on a local and global level, and to hold fundraising events in order to provide immediate relief and assistance to those suffering from chronic malnutrition and the hunger regardless of the background, race, ethnicity, or religion. In order to maximize our impact on the current efforts we may seek to collaborate with other nonprofit organizations as well as organizations, individuals and for-profit corporations within the meaning and of the authorization of the law. Said organizations must fall under the section of 501© (3) section of the Internal Revenue code and are operated exclusively for educational and federal purposes. PUBLIC-BENEFITS

NONPROFIT NATURE

Ministerio Count on Me Community Affairs, Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes including for such purposes the making of distributions to organizations that qualifies as exempt organizations under Section 501 c 3 of the Internal Revenue code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. No part of the net earnings of Ministerio Count on Me Community Affairs, Inc. shall increase or be to the benefit of or be distributable to its own members trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that their corporation shall be otherwise empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payment and the distributions in furtherance of the purpose of set forth in the purpose Clause here off.

The corporation is not organized and should not be operated for the private gain of any person. The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its educational and charitable purposes. No part of these assets, receipts, or net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any individual. The corporation may, however come up a reasonable compensation for services rendered and shall make other payments and distributions consistent with these articles.

Dissolution

Upon termination or dissolution of the corporation any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one or more qualified organizations described in section 501 c 3 of the Internal Revenue code of 1986, or similarly described in any corresponding provision of any successor statute which organization or organizations have a charitable purpose which at least generally includes a purpose

similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation. The organization to receive the assets of the Ministerio Count on me Community Affairs Inc. hereunder shall be selected by the discretion of a majority of the managing body of the corporation and of it's members can also agree then the recipient organization should be selected pursuant to a verified petition in equity filed in the court of proper jurisdiction against Ministerio Count on Me Community Affairs Inc. by one or more of its managing body which verified petition should contain such statements as reasonably indicating the applicability of this section. The court upon a finding that this section is applicable will also let the qualifying organization or organizations to receive the assets to be distributed, giving preference if practicable to organizations located within the state of Florida. In the event that the court shall find that this section is applicable at least generally but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has a charitable purpose which at least generally includes a purpose similar to this Corporation then the court shall direct the distribution of its assets lawfully available for distribution to the treasurer of the State of Florida to be added to the general fund.

Prohibited Distributions

No part of the net earnings, or properties of this Corporation on dissolution or otherwise shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to its members, directors, officers or other private persons are individuals, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose of supporting salaries to employees, organizations fees and charitable endeavors.

Restricted Activities

No substantial part of the corporation's activities shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene including the publishing or distribution of any type of statements, endorsing any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Other Prohibited Activities

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles the corporations and not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on 1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax as an organization described by section 501 c 3 of the Internal Revenue code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or 2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 c 2 of the Internal Revenue code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
