ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TURNING POINTS IN AMERICA, INC.

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The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit. Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Florida, do hereby certify. ALLAHASSEE FLORIDA

ARTICLE 1. NAME

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

If reference to federal law in articles of incorporation imposes a limitation that is invalid in your state, you may wish to substitute the following for the last sentence of the preceding paragraph: "Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation."
