NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION

AMENDED & RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of PANSHOO KIDS INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a nonprofit organization under the laws of the State of Florida, Chapter 617, F.S., hereby adapt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the organization is Panshoo Kids Inc. Business address shall be 1876 Everlee Road, Jacksonville, FL 32256.

ARTICLE II

Duration

The term of existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

Purpose and Powers

- **3.1** Purposes. The purpose for which the organization is formed is as follows:
 - 3.1.1 To provide educational opportunities to children and others in the community, by promoting literacy and making reading fun, memorable and accessible to all.
 - 3.1.2 Non-Discriminatory Policy. All activities and programs are generally accorded or made available to the community. The organization does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in administration of its educational and research programs and policies.
- 3.2 Powers. In general, and subject to such limitations and conditions as are or may be prescribed by law, or in the organization's Articles of Incorporation or Bylaws, the organization shall have all powers that now or hereafter are conferred by law upon a organization organized for the purposes set forth above, or are necessary or incidental to the powers so conferred or are conducive to the attainment of the organization's purposes.

ARTICLE IV

Limitations

- **4.1** The organization is organized exclusively for educational, research and charitable purposes, as contemplated by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code.
- 4.2 Not withstanding any other provision of these articles, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1998 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Law)(the "Code"); or (b) by a organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- **4.3** The organization shall not carry on or engage in any political campaign relating to the candidacy of any person or otherwise.
- 4.4 No part of the net income or net earnings for principal of the organization shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any member, director or officer of the organization, or any other private individual other than as a legitimate object of the purposes stated in Article Three, but reimbursements for expenditures or the payments of reasonable compensation for services rendered shall not be deemed to be a distribution of income, earnings, or principal.
- 4.5 Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE V Bylaws

The Board of Directors has full power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal the Bylaws or adopt new Bylaws for the organization at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors so long as they are not inconsistent with the provisions of these Articles.

ARTICLE VI

Amendment to Articles

The organization reserves the right to amend, alter, change, or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by law, and all rights and powers conferred herein on the members or directors are granted subject to this reserved power.

ARTICLE VII

<u>Members</u>

THERE ARE NO MEMBERS - The qualification of members, if any, the application process, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members and their liability for dues and assessments, and the method of collection thereof, shall be set forth in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII

Director Liability Limitations

To the full extent that the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act and Sections 617.0831 and 617.0834, as they exist on the date hereof or may hereafter be amended, permits the limitation or elimination of the liability of directors, a director of the organization shall not be liable to the organization for monetary damages for his or her acts or omissions as a director. Any amendment or repeal of Article Eight shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a director occurring prior to such amendment or appeal.

ARTICLE IX Board of Directors

The number of the directors of the organization is prescribed by the Bylaws of the organization. The first directors of the organization will be four, and they will serve until the first meeting of the Board of Directors and until their successors are elected and qualified.
