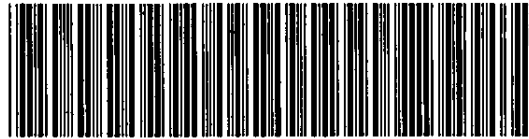

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is: To operate a school to provide nature and outdoor-based education for children as well as facilitate a community garden and low-cost evening and weekend community classes for the purpose of providing nature and agriculture education and resources in Palm Beach County. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the purposes of this corporation are limited exclusively to exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE IV MEMBERS/DIRECTORS

The corporation may (but need not) have voting members, and such membership, if any, and classes thereof, shall be as defined in the corporation's bylaws. The management and affairs of the corporation shall be at all times under the direction of a Board of Directors, whose operations in governing the corporation shall be defined by statute and by the corporation's bylaws. No member or Director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the corporation.

ARTICLE V MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected and appointed: is provided in the bylaws of the corporation.

Article VII Limitations

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article VIII Dedication of Assets

Upon the dissolution, termination, or winding up of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Palm Beach County Department of Environmental Resources Management. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of

Competent Jurisdiction of Palm Beach County, Florida, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

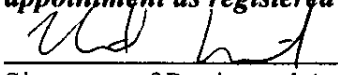

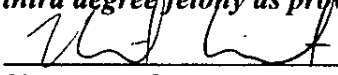
