

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of proper distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, lexing that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof.
