ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned being of legal age and competent to contract, for the purpose of organizing a not for profit corporation pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida, hereby agree and certify the following:

ARTICLE I

CORPORATE NAME

The name of the Corporation is EBENEZER THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY, INC.

ARTICLE II

COMMENCEMENT OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall commence corporate existence upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Florida Department of State, and approved by it and the respective filing fee has been paid. The Corporation shall have perpetual existence unless dissolve sooner according to law.

ARTICLE III PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND AGENT

The initial registered office and mailing address of this corporation is 13151 SW 242th Terrace, Princeton, Florida 33032, and the initial registered agent of the Corporation at that address shall be Rev. Julian Lopez. The Corporation may change its registered agent or location of its registered office, or both, from time to time without amending these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE IV

PURPOSES AND GENERAL POWERS

EBENEZER THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY, INC. is a nonprofit ecclesiastical corporation seeking authorization of the Florida State Board of Education to grant Bachelor Degrees, Master Degrees, Doctoral Degrees, and Doctor of Philosophy

Degrees with major concentrations in: Theology, Pastoral Ministry, Christian Education, Christian, and Clinical Counseling, Biblical Studies, Ministry, Marriage and Family Counseling, Church Administration, Christian Social Ministry, Chaplaincy and Divinity. These degrees will have a religious modifier as required by statute.

The Corporation shall have all of the powers enumerated in the Florida Not For Profit law and all such powers as are permitted by applicable law, including, without limitation and only by illustration, to the following:

- The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, literary or scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or under any corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, covering the distributions to organizations qualified as tax exempt organizations under the Internal Revenue Code, including private foundations and private operating foundations.
- 2. To educate the whole man, spiritually, mentally, physically and socially with emphasis up the spiritual development, sound doctrinal interpretation, and the academic vocations for ministry and leadership.
- 3. To educate students in the post-secondary studies of Christian education, ministry, music, clinical counseling, marriage and family counseling, leadership, church administration, chaplaincy, and multimedia technology.
- To educate and develop courses from the one year diploma level through the Associate, Bachelor, Master and Doctorate degrees and to acknowledge ministries through ordinations and Honors Degrees.
- 5. To carry out the educational vision of the institution at the local, state, and international level by establishing independent learning centers and joint ventures with other selected educational institutions.
- 6. To recruit and to provide students from all around the world with a Christian and intellectual formation, as well as to educate non-American students about the customs of American citizenship.
- 7. To provide, impart, and furnish post-secondary biblical studies as an institution of higher education.
- To grant students completing their religious studies at EBENEZER THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY, INC., Associate Degrees, Bachelor Degrees, Master's Degree, Doctorate Degrees, and professional

certificates upon completion of their degree programs. These degrees shall have a religious modifier.

- 9. To integrate the study of the Bible as the revealed will of God into the total curriculum.
- 10. To prepare an environment wherein biblical principles of behavior are taught, promoted and exemplified.
- 11. To establish, conduct and maintain one or more locations, academies, preparatory schools, departments or colleges within the State of Florida or elsewhere as may deemed advisable.
- 12. To purchase, take, receive, lease, take by gift, devise or bequest or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use, and otherwise deal in and with real or personal property or any interest therein, wherever situated.
- 13. To sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, create security interests in, lease, exchange, transfer, and otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets.
- 14. To conduct its business, carry on its operations, and have offices and exercise the powers granted by the Florida Not For Profit Law or by any other applicable law within or without the State of Florida.
- 15. To elect or appoint Officers and Agents and define their duties and allow them reasonable compensation.
- 16. To provide clinical supervision for Christian counseling.
- 17. To provide supervised practical experience in ministry vocations.
- 18. To provide a basis for support group formation and fellowship.
- 19. To provide training for faith based organizations to serve the community.
- 20. To examine candidates for the ministry and to Ordain as Ministers those who shall meet the requirements of this educational institution.

ARTICLE IV

MEMBERSHIP

The members of this Not For Profit Corporation, if any, shall be qualified and admitted as set forth in the Bylaws of this corporation.

ARTICLE V INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The initial three (3) incorporators shall be the Board of Directors. The number of Directors may be either increased or decreased from time to time as provided in the Bylaws. The name and street addresses of the initial Directors of this Corporation are:

ARTICLE VI

MANNER OF ELECTION

The future vacancies on the Board of Directors shall be filled accordingly:

- a. The President and Vice-President shall nominate Director candidates, and a Quorum of the Board of Directors shall grant final approval. If the number of Directors then in office is less than a quorum, a vacancy on the board may be filled by approval of a majority of the directors then in office or by a sole remaining director. A person elected to fill a vacancy on the Board shall hold office until the next election of the Board of Directors or until his or her death, resignation or removal from office.
- b. The affairs of the organization shall be managed by an Executive Committee which will be elected every two (2) years by the Board of Directors. The Executive Committee will consists of a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. The Board of Directors will consist of no less than three (3) members and no more than fifteen (15). For a meeting of the Board of Directors a quorum of two-thirds of its members is required with the attendance of the President and Secretary or their representatives, as a mandatory requisite.

- c. The Board of Directors will have meetings at least four (4) during each year and resolutions will be adopted by the majority of the votes.
- d. The Board of Directors shall be responsible for the interpretation, implementation and supplementation of these articles.

ARTICLE VII

BYLAWS

Bylaws will be hereinafter adopted at the first meeting of the Board of Directors. Except as otherwise provided by law, the power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal the Bylaws shall be vested in resolutions of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VIII

INDEMNIFICATION

In addition to any rights and duties under applicable law, the Corporation shall indemnify and hold harmless all its Directors, Officers, employees and agents, and former Directors, Officers, employees and agents from and against all liabilities and obligations. including Attorney's Fees incurred in connection with any actions taken or failed to be taken by said Directors, Officers, employees and agents in their capacity as such except for willful misconduct or gross negligence.

ARTICLE IX LIABILITY

No member of **EBENEZER THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY**, **INC.** shall be liable for its debts nor shall any members' property be so liable.

ARTICLE IX AMENDMENTS

The Corporation reserves the right to repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation. These Articles of Incorporation may also be amended as necessary from time to time pursuant to the provisions of the law of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE X FEDERAL EXEMPTIONS

1. <u>Federal Income Tax Exemption</u>: Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section § 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under IRC Section 501(c) (3) or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.

2. <u>No Private Inurement</u>: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, director, officer of the corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation), and no member, trustee, officer of the corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation.

3. <u>Lobbying and Participation in Political Campaigns</u>: No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by IRC Section 501(h)) or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidates for public office.

4. <u>Federal Excise Taxes</u>: In any taxable year in which the corporation is a private foundation as describe in IRC Section 509(a), the corporation shall distribute its income for said period at such time and manner as not to subject it to tax under IRC Section 4942, and the corporation shall not: (a) engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in IRC Section 4941(d), retain any (b) excess business holdings as defined IRC Section 4943(c), make any investments in such manner as to subject the corporation to tax under IRC Section 4944, or (c) make any taxable expenditures as defined in IRC Section 4945(d) or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.

5. <u>Dissolution</u>: In the event of dissolution, all of the remaining assets and property of the corporation shall, after necessary expenses thereof, be distributed to another organization exempt under IRC Section 501(c) (3), or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws or to the Federal government, or state or local government for a public purpose, subject to the approval of any pertinent court.
