ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

TO THE

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

DADE CITY POLICE FOUNDATION, INC. N16000007307

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1006 of the Florida Statutes.

<u>Dade City Police Foundation, Inc.</u>, a Florida Not For Profit Corporation (the "Corporation"), adopts the following amendments to its Articles of Incorporation:

- 1. The Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation were originally filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida on <u>July 26, 2016</u>.
- 2. The following Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was recommended by the Board of Directors in accordance with the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of the Corporation, on <u>December 6</u>, 2018.

(a) Article III of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation is hereby amended by deleting Article II in its entirety, and substituting the following therefore, to wit:

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The primary purpose of the corporation shall be to serve the City of Dade City through support of the Dade City Police Department. This service will include the purchase and care of trained police animals, equipment and officer assistance. The corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized or empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing in or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

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ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any activity not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt under section 501(e)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(e)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code or shall be disposed of to the federal government, state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county where the principal office of the corporation is located, exclusively for the exempt purposes identified hereinabove or to such organization or organizations as the court shall determine to be organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

- 3. Excepting the foregoing Amendment(s) to the Articles of Incorporation, the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation, as previously amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
- 4. There were no members or members entitled to vote on this amendment. The amendment was adopted by the board of directors.
- 5. The foregoing Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation shall be effective upon filing with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida.
