Care to Dance, Inc. ("CTD") is a not-for-profit wellness education and charitable organization.

Core Mission and Activity

CTD provides educational, physical and mental health support to individuals and families adversely affected by dementia as a result Alzheimer's, Parkinson's and other degenerative neurological diseases. Ballroom dancing and its unique techniques are employed as a vehicle to positively affect and improve cognitive abilities and memory. The combination of dance and music enhances and enriches the quality of life of its participants, reduces isolation from family members, guardians and caregivers, improves balance and mental health. Studies document the cardiovascular benefits to dementia sufferers from both the physical activity and music consequent to dancing. More recent studies have provided further support for dance therapy with confirmation of improvement in cognitive and mental acuity for those participating.

CTD presents programs at nursing, assisted-living and similar facilities and for various community and senior groups on frequent and regular schedules. Programs are conducted by experienced instructors and dancers, including trained volunteers. After dance movements are explained and demonstrated, the instructors assist and lead the participants on the dance floor. Participants need not be ambulatory – routines are adapted for those using wheel chairs, canes, chairs or walkers. Participants actually dance and care partners and family members are encouraged to join with the participant creating a mutually beneficial experience.

CTD founders and volunteers have conducted approaching 100 such programs to date throughout central Florida. Improvements to memory, mental health and physical activity are regularly observed by CTD and consistently reported by participants, care partners, guardians and family members.

CTD's founders are members of the American Dance Therapy Association and are active and experienced in ballroom dancing programs outside the realm of CTD. CTD volunteers are multi-lingual and diverse in age, education and profession, ethnicity and national origin allowing maximum service to the individuals and communities served.

Ancillary Activity and Accessibility to Program

CTD is expanding to provide accessibility to its program to those that still live at home with dementia. Demonstration programs to non-profit organizations and senior groups encourage inclusion of dance therapy within their related programs.

CTD, in partnership with a non-profit mental health organization, has initiated a program for early to mid-stage dementia sufferers who live at home. CTD's core program is conducted at a local church with plans to expand to other locations.

CTD seeks and encourages sponsorship by individuals, foundations and businesses to continue and expand the program for the benefit of those suffering with dementia,
